A petition asking for grade on Grant Street signed by property owners on said Street was read and referred to the Grade Committee.

A petition from property owners on Linden Avenue between Main Street and Broadway asking that Dr Shaffer and Lee Fording be appointed as the Citizens committee to supervise the improvement of said Linden Avenue was read and Brinker moved the request of

The petitioners be granted, and that Dr. Shaffer and Lee Tording be appointed as said committee seconded by Keplinger and carried.

The sidewalk committee to whom had been referred the present sidewalk Ordinance reported as having consulted an attorney and the opinion given was that the Ordinance was good and sufficient for the construction of sidewalks. Kayler moved the adoption of the report seconded by Brinker and lost. yeas Bush Jenkins Kayler Wilson. Nays Brinker Cowan Earley Keplinger Love. yeas 4 may 25.

Kayler moved that a committee of three be appointed to confer with the officials of the Penna R.R. Co relative to the construction of the proposed sewer along the south side of the railroad between Freedom Street and the C & P R.R. seconded by Bush and carried. President Wilson then appointed as said committee. Kayler Bush and Brinker.

Kayler called attention of Council to the probability of the sewer now being constructed in the second ward, not being deep enough to drain the proposed sewer along the railroad. Should said sewer be made deep enough to drain the cellars near the east end of Main Street, and Brinker moved that the sewer committee be empowered to have the Buck Street sewer lowered in conformity therewith if deemed necessary, seconded by Kayler and carried yeas 9 may 20.

The committee to whom had been referred the vacation of the alley between property of S. J. Williams and R. H. Peters reported as follows. "The your committee to whom was referred the question of vacating the alley between S. J. Williams and R. H. Peters would recommend that the alley be vacated." Signed J. K. Jenkins Alex Cowan. On motion of Kayler seconded by Bush the report was adopted.

Locating Sidewalks
on Seneca st

Bush offered the following resolution and moved its adoption: "Be it resolved that it is the sense of this council that the space between the curb and sidewalk on Seneca Avenue for all sidewalks south of Broad Street shall be three feet."

Kayler seconded the motion to adopt. The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Bush Leowan Jenkins Kayler Keplinger Love Wilson Nays Brinker and Carley yeas 7 nays 2. and the resolution was declared adopted.

The claims Ordinance providing for the payment of \$5000 to C. E. Selin being prepared was read. and Jenkins moved the passage of the same seconded by Brinker and carried. Yeas Bush Brinker Jenkins Kayler Keplinger Loue Wilson. Yeas 7 nays none.
