Council met in Special session

President Wilson stated the object of the meeting
 under the call to be for the purpose of considering
 permanent street improvements, to take action
 on the construction and repair of sidewalks, to
 consider the report of the water committee and
 for the reading and passage of a sidewalk

Ordinance and the Broadway Grade Ordinance

Bids having been received on August 22nd
 for the improvement of Arch Street from Alder
 Street south to State Street, and for Ely
 Street from Park Street west to the Corporation

Passage of
 Sidewalk
 Ordinance

An Ordinance To provide for
 the construction and repair of sidewalks was
 read first time and Bush moved the rules
 be suspended and the ordinance be read second
 time by title seconded by Bush and Carried
 Yeas 9 nays 0. The ordinance was read second
 time by title and Bush moved the rules be
 again suspended and the ordinance be read third
 time and be placed on its final passage, seconded
 by Brinker and Carried, Yeas, 9 nays 0. The
 ordinance was then read third time and the
 yeas and nays called on the final passage of the
 same resulting yeas Brinker Bush Crabbaugh
 Drvine Junipers Kayler Kiplinger Love
 Wilson Yeas 9 nays 0. and the ordinance
 was declared duly passed

The following resolution was read.

Resolution
collect
cost of
sidewalks

"Be it resolved by the council of the city of Alliance Ohio that as soon as any sidewalk shall have been laid according to the sidewalk ordinance. the sidewalk committee shall furnish the city clerk with a bill of the cost of Laying the same who shall serve notice on the property owner to pay the same within ten days and if not ~~so~~ paid the city clerk shall return the same to the county Auditor for collection according to law."

Brinker moved the adoption of the resolution seconded by Devine and carried yeas 9 nays 0.

The Water committee to whom had been referred the matter of making new contract with the water works company. made the following report:

Report of
Water committee
new Contract

"We are of the opinion that a contract should be made to run a period of eight (8) years at a yearly rental not to exceed forty dollars (\$40.00) per plug and thirteen (13) plugs per mile and that the water mains be extended to the sixth ward the extension to be completed on or before Oct 1st 1892

The council to locate any and all plugs after the date of the new contract. the number of plugs per mile to apply only to extensions of mains laid after date of new contract."

Kayler moved the adoption of the report seconded by Brinker and carried.

On motion of Brinker the water committee was instructed to continue on the making of contract until completed.

Ordinance

An Ordinance to amend the grade on Broadway. was read third time and Bush moved the same be placed on its final passage. seconded by Brinker. The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Brinker Bush Crumbaugh Devine Janstons Kayler Kupleinger Love Wilson yeas 9 nays 0. and President Wilson declared the ordinance passed.

Weybrecht's
Water Pipe

The matter of Putting in larger water pipe on Linden Avenue from Broadway to J. T. Weybrecht's property was on motion of Brinker referred to the water committee

The following resolution was read:

Sidewalk and
Grade Committee
to give grades

Be it resolved that it is the sense of this Council that whenever it is thought necessary to have grade stakes set for the purpose of constructing sidewalks the city engineer shall when instructed by the grade and sidewalk committee proceed to have the work done without delay and the engineer shall be required to furnish a report to council once each month."

Bush moved the adoption of the same seconded by Brinker and carried. Yeas 8 nays 0.
