

Aliance Ohio Sept 9th 1891

Council met in adjourned session with Vice President Bush presiding and members Brinker Crubough Jenkins Kayler Keplinger and Love present. absent Cowan Devine Carley Kynnett and Wilson.

The Valuation of the lots and lands on Arch Street between Midway and State Streets was presented and Brinker reported that the Valuation was such that it would not warrant the proceeding with improvement unless the property owners would sign a waiver. and on motion the bids were allowed to lay over without further action until the next meeting of Council.

Brinker moved that all bids for the improvement of Patterson Street from Freedom to Hester Avenue be rejected and the work advertised for again in the Spring. seconded by Kayler and Carried.

Brinker Moved that all bids for the improvement of Ely Street be rejected and the work be advertised for again in the Spring. seconded by Kayler and Carried.

In regard to the bids for Liberty Street improvement it was decided that it would be necessary to readvertise as the former bids had not been advertised for as long as required by law. and some changes being desired in the specifications they were amended and as amended were read and on motion of Jenkins seconded by Brinker adopted.

and on motion of Brinker all bids for the Liberty Street improvement were rejected.

On Motion of Brinker it was agreed that when council adjourn it be to meet Monday evening Sept 14th
