 Ordinance being prepared was read and
 Brinker moved the final passage of
 the same seconded by Love and
 carried yeas 9 nays 0.

Committee to
 look after
 city's interest
 in law suits

Bush moved that a committee
 of two consisting of Brinker and
 Corley be appointed to look after the
 city's interest in the cases of Kate
 Loftus and Postetter against the city
 and any other cases now pending

in which there have been no committees appointed to look after seconded by Kayler and carried yeas 9 nays 0.

resolution to amend grade on Linden

Devine offered a resolution to amend the grade on Linden Avenue between Columbia Street and Broadway by raising the same one foot at the alley between said streets and connecting the grade points by a vertical curve, and moved the adoption of the same. seconded by Jenkins.

Brinker moved to amend by making the change at the Alley read six inches instead of one foot seconded by Bush the yeas and nays were called one the amendment resulting yeas Brinker Bush Jenkins Kayler. nays Crumbayh ~~Devine~~ ^{Carley} Keplinger Love Wilson yeas 4 nays 5. The motion to amend was declared lost and the yeas and nays called on the original motion

report of Water-Committee

The Water committee made the following report: We your committee on Water beg leave to report our conclusions as follows: first we would recommend that all old hydrants be rented at a rate of \$40.00 per hydrant per year and all Hydrants ordered by Council after the new contract has been signed shall be paid for at a rate of \$45.00 per year.
