Notice was given to council that A. B. Strong having been elected to the office of city solicitor at the election held Nov 3rd had qualified and given Bond and was now authorized to act in that official capacity.

A number of Bills against the city having been approved by the proper committees were read and Love moved they be accepted and allowed and that an Ordinance be prepared for their payment and the same be placed on its passage seconded by Cornbough and carried.

The above Ordinance being prepared was read and the yeas and nays called on the final passage of the same resulting Yeas Bush Cornbough Devine Early Jenkins Kayler Kynnett Love Wilson Yeas 9 nays 0. and the Ordinance was declared duly passed.

The your Committee on fire beg leave to report the following: Mr. Frank Stanley makes the city a proposition ^{to furnish} one good horse and feed the same for the use of the fire Dept and devote his entire time to the Department for the sum of Fifty dollars per month. we also have the names of six good men that have agreed to assist Mr Stanley at all fires. to be paid at the rate of Forty cents per hour while on duty at fires

The city to furnish a place to keep the horse.
 We find this proposition would cost the city as follows:

Bush moved that the above specifications be also amended to read six rich tile instead of eight rich tile. seconded by Jenkins and carried yeas 9 nays 0.
