

Alliance Ohio Nov 16. 1891

Council met in regular session with President Wilson in the Chair and the following Members present. Brinker Bush Crumbaugh Jenkins Kayler ~~Keplinger~~ Love Absent Cowan Drvine Early Keplinger & Kynett Minutes of Preceding meeting read and approved.

The following communication from Robert Auld was read. "To the Council of the city of Alliance Ohio: Gentlemen, My bid for the macadamizing of South Liberty Avenue having been accepted by the Council. if permission is granted me to do so I hereby agree to do such part of the excavation and filling or other part of the work as the citizens committee or Council may direct when the weather will permit and wait for my pay until such time as the money may be in the fund to pay for that improvement from the sale of Bonds?" signed Robert Auld.

Bush offered the following resolution and moved its adoption: "Be it resolved that it is the sense of this council that the contractor Mr Auld of the South Liberty Avenue improvement be required to excavate and put in place the five lengths of iron pipe in the ravine on South Liberty Avenue the work to be done under the supervision of the citizens committee and shall be done to their full satisfaction and the said contractor shall receive for his services the stone that were used to build a stone culvert which has lately fallen down so much so as to be dangerous."

Kayler seconded the motion to adopt. The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Brinker Bush Orbaugh Jenkins Kayler Love Wilson. Yeas 7 nays none and the resolution was declared adopted.

The contract with the Alliance water works company having expired a new contract having been prepared was read also a resolution authorizing the Mayor and Clerk to sign said contract on the part of the city. The resolution was adopted yeas 7 nays 0. with instructions to submit said contract to the Water Works Company. On motion Council adjourned.
