

Alliance Ohio December 21. 1891

Council met in regular session with Vice president Bush presiding and the following members present. Brinker Cowan Crumbaugh Devine Earley Kayler Kephlinger Kyoutt and Love. Absent Jenkins and Wilson. Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

Notice was read of Mrs Caroline E. Their having commenced action against the city to prevent the collection of the assessment against her property for the improvement of Arch Street.

Brinker moved that there be a committee appointed to act with the solicitor in ascertaining the facts in the case and take charge of the said case. seconded by Love and carried. President Bush then appointed Brinker Crumbaugh and Love as said committee.

#### Special Committee

Brinker reported as having completed the contract with the county commissioners and county Auditor with reference to the renumbering of the city and the city map and had received the sum of \$2600<sup>00</sup> from said commissioners toward the cost of the same. and moved the report be accepted and the money be placed in the general fund of the city seconded by Devine and carried.

Certain bills against the city having been approved by the finance committee were read and Brinker moved the same be allowed and an Ordinance prepared providing for their payment and the same be placed on its passage. seconded by Devine and carried. The Ordinance being prepared was read and the gas and maps called on the passage of the same resulting Yeas 13 nays 0. Brinker Bush Cowan Crumbaugh Devine Kayler Kephlinger Earley Love Yeas 9 nays none and the ordinance was declared passed.

Brinker offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

Be it resolved by the Council of the city of the city of Alliance Ohio that the Telephone Company be notified to repair all lawns and sidewalks that were taken up or damaged by the erection of the new poles of said company, and be it further resolved that if said Telephone company fails to make said repairs within ten days after the passage of this resolution and notice to them of the same, the sidewalk committee of Council be and they are hereby instructed to make said repairs and the cost of the same to be at the expense of said Telephone company and if not paid upon presentation of the bill, the said bill of expense to be placed in the hands of the city solicitor for collection.

and be it further resolved that the City Clerk serve a copy of this resolution on said Telephone Company

Kayler seconded the motion to adopt. The yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas 10 nays 0, and the resolution was declared adopted.

Kayler seconded the motion to adopt. The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas 10 nays none, and the resolution was declared adopted.

Brinker moved the rules be suspended and the ordinance be read second time by title seconded by Keplinger.

The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Brinker Bush Cowan Lerbough Davine Earley Kayler Keplinger & Love Yeas 9 nays none the rules were declared suspended the ordinance was read second time by title and Love moved that the rules be again suspended and the ordinance be read third time and placed on its final passage. seconded

by Brinker. The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Brinker Bush Cowan Eschbaugh Devine Kayler Heplings Love. Nays Earley. Yeas & nays 1 and the motion was declared lost.

All additions here after. no addition to the city be accepted to be drawn on city Map unless the same be thoroughly platted and the parties presenting the plat agree to have the same drawn on the city map. seconded by Kayler and carried.

To prepare ordinance to regulate height of frame buildings

On motion of Kayler seconded by Brinker the Judiciary Committee and Solicitor were instructed to prepare an Ordinance regulating the height of frame buildings on Main Street between the Union Depot and Mechanic Street.
