

Council Chamber. Alliance Ohio January 4. 1842

Council met in regular session with president Wilson in the Chair and the following members present

Brinker Bush. Crubaugh Jenkins Kayler Keplinger Kynett Love.

Davis arriving during the session on motion of Love the reading of the Minutes was dispensed with.

Reading of bills
and passage of
Claims Ordinance

A number of bills against the City having been approved by the proper Committees were read. and Brinker moved the same be allowed and that an Ordinance be prepared providing for their payment. seconded by Crubaugh and Carried. The ordinance being prepared and there not being sufficient money in certain funds to pay the appropriations provided for in said ordinance Brinker moved that there be apportioned from the unapportioned fund to the Sanitary fund \$700 to the Street fund \$3⁰⁰ and to the general fund \$79.94 seconded by Crubaugh and Carried.

The Ordinance providing for the payment of the bills read and allowed was then read. and Brinker moved the passage of the same seconded by Love and Carried.

Brinker offered a resolution instructing the city clerk to confer with the Councils of Canton Massillon and Louisville and the County Commissioners asking them each to appoint a committee to confer with a like committee from this Council to consider the feasibility of building a work house in Stark County and moved the adoption of the same seconded by Bush and Carried yeas 9 nays 0.

A Ordinance to provide for the issuing of the bonds of the City of Alliance Ohio for the purpose of extending time of payment of certain indebtedness which from its limits of taxation said city is unable to pay at maturity was read second time by title and Bush moved the rules be suspended and the ordinance be read third time and be placed on its final passage seconded by Brinker. The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Brinker Bush Crutbaugh Duvine Jenkins Keyler Keplinger Love Wilson Nay Kynett yeas 9 nays 0. The ordinance was read third time and the yeas and nays were called on the final passage of the same resulting yeas Brinker Bush Crutbaugh Duvine Jenkins Keyler Keplinger Kynett Love Wilson yeas 10 nays 0 and the ordinance was declared passed.
