Mrs Stockwell being present asked  
 for an extension of time in which to pay for  
 sidewalk constructed in front of lot 32.  
 by the city. and on motion of Bush the same  
 was referred to the finance committee.

Kayler moved that the fire committee  
 be instructed to purchase six lanterns and  
 one hose nozzle. seconded by Brinker and  
 carried. Yeas 9 nays 0.

Kayler presented the names of David Moore

 of the same. seconded by Bush and carried  
 Yeas 9 nays 0.

Fire committee  
 to sell cart

Kayler reported that the fire  
 committee had an opportunity to sell the  
 old fire police cart for \$2500 and on motion  
 of Low the matter was referred to the  
 fire committee with power to act. Yeas 9-nays 0

side of the P. F. W. & C. R. R. seconded  
by Kayler and Carried.

Bush presented plat of Auld's  
second addition and moved the same  
be referred to the platting commission  
seconded by Keplinger and Carried

Brinker moved that there be  
a committee of three appointed to confer with  
the committees of Council from Canton, Massillon  
Louisville and the County Commissioners  
in regard to building a workhouse.  
Seconded by Bush and Carried.
