The Mayor's report for the months of December and January showing fines and licenses to the amount of \$55⁵⁰ was read and on motion of Brinker the same was accepted and ordered placed on file.

sidewalk
The Finance Committee to whom had been referred the matter of granting Mas Stockwell further time in which to pay the city for sidewalk in front of Lot 32. reported in favor of extending the time of payment until March 1st 1892 and that if not paid by that time the Clerk proceed to collect the same. and on motion of Kayler the report was accepted.

A number of bills having been approved by the proper committees were read and Brinker moved the same be allowed and an Ordinance be prepared providing for their payment seconded by Love and carried.

The Ordinance being prepared Brinker moved the same be read and placed on its passage. seconded by Crutbaugh and carried.

The ordinance was read and the roll called on the passage of the same resulting.

 on Broadway

Bush called attention to the necessity of a sidewalk crossing over a certain ravine on East Broadway east of Keybrecht's planing mill and moved the same be referred to the sidewalk committee with power to act seconded by Brinker and carried. "We the undersigned committee on Buildings and grounds would recommend that there be furnished in the first, second, third and fifth wards of the city ward houses for the purpose of watering places, and we would recommend the size to be built 16 x 24 one story high of 10 ft story. we find that the cost would be about \$225⁰⁰. first class material to be used."

"Whereas the late decision of the Supreme Court of the state of Ohio on the legality of the prohibitory ordinance adopted by the city of Alliance Ohio is in favor of the city and the ordinance. Therefore, Be it resolved, by the council of the city of Alliance Ohio that it is necessary to employ one or more additional police

officers for such time as may be thought necessary. and Be it further resolved that an appropriation of one hundred dollars be made and placed in the hands of the Mayor of the city of Alliance for the enforcement of said ordinance"

Jenkins seconded the motion to adopt. The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Brinker Bush Brown Jenkins Kayler Keplinger Love Wilson Day Crutank. yeas 8 nays 1. Mr. Kynett having been excused retired.

The committee appointed to investigate the workhouse question having visited Janesville and inspected the workhouse located there reported favorably to the erection of one in Stark County and offered the following resolution; Be it resolved by the Council of the city of Alliance Ohio that in our judgment a workhouse should be speedily erected at some point in Stark County Ohio for the use of said county at a cost not to exceed \$50,000⁰⁰

That the Commissioners of said County are hereby requested to procure all necessary legislation to establish said workhouse and if it be necessary to submit the question as to whether or not the county shall erect a workhouse to the legal voters thereof the said Commissioners are urged to provide for such submission at the next regular election in April. That the clerk is hereby directed to send a copy of this resolution to the Commissioners of this County
