Council met in regular Session with President Wilson presiding and the following members present. Brinker Bush Cruborough Devine Carley Jenkins Kayler Love. Absent Cowan Keplinger and Kynett.

On motion of Bush the City Solicitor was instructed to ascertain the line of the L.C. & S Railway Company's right of way at the point where said Railway crosses Broadway and report at next meeting.

Report of
valuation
Market St

The Clerk reported the valuation of real estate on Market Street between Arch Street and Union Avenue in view of the proposed improvement of said Market Street and it was ascertained that quite a number of the lots would not bear the assessment estimating the cost of the same at three dollars per foot front and on motion of Brinker seconded by Bush the Clerk was instructed to refer the matter back to the petitioners to secure a waiver of the property owners whose property would not bear the assessment.

On Motion of Brinker seconded by Kayler the Clerk was instructed to notify the petitioners for the improvement of Oly Street from Park Street west to the corporation line that a waiver would be required by Council from the property owners whose property would not bear the assessment.

An Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance to prohibit connecting with a sewer therein described" was read the first time and Bush moved that the rules be suspended and the ordinance be read second time by title seconded by Kayler and Carried. The Ordinance was read second time by title and Jenkins moved the rules be again suspended and the Ordinance be read Third Time

An Ordinance to
 prohibit nuisances was read first
 time and Brinker moved the same
 be referred back to the Judiciary
 Committee with instructions to
 substitute an ordinance for the special
 purpose of protecting the grounds of
 the Park located occupied by the Sewer
 along the south side of the R.R.
 between Freedom Street and the
 to V.P.R.R.

Kayler made following report
 on the above described sewer.
 Total Cost \$6734¹ Total amt subscribed
 by private individuals \$6332⁵
 Total amt Paid \$48 25
 Bal unpaid \$5.11
 Balance due on Construction \$133.47
 Title turned over to the city. Value \$53.

On Motion of Bush the report was accepted and
 ordered placed on file. and Brinker moved
 that the city assume the indebtedness yet due
 on said sewer. seconded by Kayler
 and Carried. Yeas 9 nays 0.
