

Council Chamber Alliance Ohio March 7th 1892

Council met in regular session with President Wilson Presiding and the following members present. Brinker Cowan Crubough Drove Earley Jenkins Kayler Keplinger Kymett Love. Absent Bush. Minutes of preceding meetings read and approved.

A Communication from the president of the Water Works Company asking that Council take some action to prevent sewerage of the city from being deposited in the water works tank was read and referred to the Sewer Committee.

A Petition asking for a curber sidewalk on north Union Avenue from the C & P R.R. to the north Corporation line was referred to the sidewalk Committee.

The Mayors report for the month of February showing fines and licenses collected to the amount of \$91⁰⁰ was read and on motion of Brinker the same was accepted and ordered placed on file.

A number of Bills having been approved by the proper committees were read and Brinker moved they be allowed and placed in the Claims Ordinance and the same be read and placed on its final passage seconded by Crubough and Carried.

Earley asked for separate vote on the bill of Robert Learmonth for Balance due on the West Main Street Contract. and Jenkins asked for separate vote on the bill of T. D. Paul for balance due on the City Map.

The yeas and nays were called on Learmonth's bill and Brinker, Crubough Drove Jenkins Kayler Keplinger Love and Wilson voted in favor of paying the same and Earley Cowan and Kymett voted against it.

The motion to amend was declared carried as was also the original motion as amended.

Love offered the following resolution and moved its adoption. "Be it resolved that the Solicitor be instructed to prepare an Ordinance regulating the office of Street Commissioner". Brinker seconded the motion to adopt. The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas 11 nays none. and the resolution was declared adopted.

An Ordinance entitled an Ordinance to prohibit certain nuisances therein described was read first time and Brinker moved the rules be suspended and the ordinance be read second time by title. seconded by Kayler. The yeas
