

Alliance Ohio March 28. 1892

Council met in special session upon the following call of the Mayor.

You are hereby notified that a special meeting of the Alliance City Council is called to meet on Monday evening March 28. 1892 for the purpose of hearing the report of the finance Committee and the Clerk's annual report and for the ~~reading~~ consideration of plats and the reading and passage of the Liberty Street Assessing Ordinance and an ordinance regulating the Street Commissioners and passage of sidewalk resolutions" with president Wilson in the Chair and the following members present Brinker Cowan. Corubaugh. Jenkins Kayler Kynett. Love.

The Finance committee reported having settled with the treasurer and having compared the Books and vouchers and found them to correspond. The Clerk reported the condition of the finances for the Year ending March 21. 1892 as follows

Jenkins's  
addition

Jenkins presented an addition to his former plat of Jenkins's Addition and stated that after the acceptance of the said Plat by Council and prior to the recording of the same he had sold a portion of said addition in bulk. constituting what originally comprised nineteen lots. and now desired to add to the plat a strip of land which had not before been platted and containing nineteen lots. and asked to have them accepted and given the same numbers that had been given to the nineteen lots sold.

Brinker moved the same be accepted and that the engineer be instructed to give said lots Nos 3038. to 3056 inclusive seconded by Love and Carried.
