Kynnett of the Committee having in charge the case of W. Laughlin against the City reported as being ready for trial at any time but the case having as yet never been called up, could make no further report of progress. He also reported no expenditure of money in the case and the amount appropriated for the purpose (\$50<sup>00</sup>) yet in his hands and as he was about to retire from the Council. Love moved that the report be accepted and the money be returned to the treasury and be credited to the fund from which it was originally drawn seconded by
