Council met in regular session with president Wilson presiding and the following members present. Brinker Cowan Crubaugh Drvine Earley Jenkins Kayler Love. Absent. Bush Keplinger and Kynett.

Minutes of preceding meetings read and approved. The Mayor's report for the month of April showing fines and licenses to the amount of \$950 collected. was read and on motion of Love the same was accepted and ordered placed on file.

The Mayor's annual report for the year ending April 1<sup>st</sup> 1892. showing fines and licenses collected for the year to be \$445<sup>47</sup>. Total number of arrests 205.

152 for drunkenness. 35 for disorderly conduct and 11 for other misdemeanors. was read and on motion of Kayler the same was accepted and ordered placed on file.

An Ordinance Entitled  
An Ordinance to assess a special tax on the real estate bounding on South Liberty street from Summit Street to the south side of Wilkes street and to issue bonds in the anticipation of the collection of such assessment was read first time Jenkins moved the rules be suspended and the Ordinance be read second time by title seconded by Brinker and carried yes 9 nays 0. The ordinance was read second time by title and Brinker moved the rules be suspended and the ordinance be read third time and be placed on its final passage. seconded by Kayler

and Carried Yeas 9 nays 0. The Ordinance was read third time and the yeas and nays called on the final passage of the same resulting Yeas Brinker Cowan Combaugh Divine Earley Jenkins Kayler Love Wilson. Yeas 9 nays 0. and the ordinance was declared passed.

On Motion of Divine seconded by Kayler the taking of the inventory of tools in the hands of the street Commissioner was referred back to the street committee and on motion of Earley the Clerk was instructed to notify Mr. Beverington the outgoing Street Commissioner to have all tools in his hands belonging to the City placed together that an inventory of the same might be taken.

This being the last meeting of this Council the minutes of the meeting was read and approved. after which President Wilson addressed the Council reviewing the work done by them congratulating the members for the manner in which they had performed their duties and thanking them for the courtesy shown him as the presiding officer. Kayler moved that Council tender Mr. Wilson a vote of thanks for the manner in which he had fulfilled his office as president of the Council. seconded by Divine and Carried.

New Council Organization

After the out-going Council had adjourned. Mayor Excell occupied the Chair and the Clerk read the names of the newly elected members of Council - as follows: first ward. Alex Cowan Second ward Phil Gabele Third Ward C. H. Bush. Fourth Ward A. B. Love Fifth ward Jno W. Buck. Sixth Ward. Thos Wilson.

Who all responded except C. H. Bush. Mayor Excell then administered the oath of office to those present and called the Council to order. The roll was called showing the following members present. Brinker <sup>Buck</sup> Cowan Crumbaugh Divine Earley Gabele Jenkins Kayler Love and Wilson.

The Mayor stated that the next duty of Council would be to elect a president and vice president for the ensuing year and Brinker nominated Mr Wilson for president. Love seconded the nomination. There being no other nominations. The roll was called on Mr Wilson's nomination resulting yeas Brinker Buck Cowan Crumbaugh Divine Earley Gabele Jenkins Kayler Love. Yeas 10 nays 0. and Mr Wilson was declared elected.

Love nominated Mr Bush for Vice President Brinker seconded the nomination and there being no other nominations the roll was called resulting yeas Brinker Buck Crumbaugh Divine Jenkins Kayler Gabele Love Wilson Nays Earley Cowan Yeas 9 nays 2 and Mr Bush was declared elected.

Mayor Excell then retired from the Chair and called Mr Wilson to the same who came forward and thanked Council for the honor conferred upon him in again electing him to the presidency of this Council. Brinker moved that when Council adjourns it be to meet on Monday evening April 25<sup>th</sup>. The motion was seconded by Love and carried thereby blasting the hopes of the City Clerk who had intended

to attend the Circus on that evening.

Mayor Excell then addressed the Council pledging his hearty support <sup>to</sup> and cooperation with Council in the enforcement of the laws and ordinances of the city, and recommended the revision of the Criminal ordinances of the city, and also that in view of the difficulty in the enforcing of the prohibiting Ordinance that there be another policeman added to the force.

also some suggestions and recommendation in regard to the sanitary condition of the City.

Love stated that Mr A. F. Hicke intended erecting a building at the corner of Main and Arch streets and desired permission to use three feet of the sidewalk along said building for a cellar way, and to use a portion of the street to place lumber and material during the erection of the building, and moved that permission for the same be granted seconded by Brinker and carried

Brinker called attention to several <sup>in which the city is interested</sup> law suits, likely to come before the Court next term, and moved that a special committee be appointed to give such attention as was necessary to them until such time as regular committees could be appointed for that purpose seconded by Love and carried Yeas 9 nays 0. President Wilson then appointed Brinker Love and Divine as said committee.

No further business Council adjourned
