 and carried. On Motion of Kayler
 seconded by Brinker the Street
 Committee were empowered.

Petition to
have Census
taken.

A Petition signed by the Standard Review Pub Co and Mr. B. Excele proprietor of the Weekly Leader asking that a census of the city be taken by wards, was read and Brinker moved that there be a committee appointed to act with the representatives of the newspapers in having such census taken and that the city pay one half of the expense incurred thereby and the printing companies pay one half. Seconded by Love and Carried Yeas 10 nays 0.

Engineers to

Brinker moved that the Engineer be instructed to set grade stakes for sidewalks for E. C. Bates on South Union Avenue and for Clark Early on North Union Ave. Seconded by Keyler and Carried. Yeas 10 nays 0.

An Ordinance Entitled. An Ordinance to fix the ^{board and} salary and prescribe the duties of the City Street Commissioner and to repeal an Ordinance therein named. was read first time. and Love moved that the rules be suspended and the ordinance be read second time by title. seconded by Kayler and Carried Yeas 10 nays 0. The Ordinance was read second time by title. Jenkins moved the rules be again suspended and the Ordinance be read third time seconded by Kayler and Carried Yeas 8 nays 0. Devine Voting nay. The ordinance was read third time.

Devine Moved to amend the Ordinance so as to allow the Street Commissioner to use one team of his own on the streets if satisfactory to the Street Committee. ^{see by Kayler} Jenkins moved to amend the proposed amendment by striking out the words one team. ^{see by} Love The yeas and nays were called on the motion to amend the amendment resulting Yeas Jenkins Love Nays Brinker Buck Devine Cowan Embaugh Gabele. Kayler Nilson Yeas 2 nays 8. The motion to amend was declared lost. and Jenkins moved to refer the ordinance to the Judiciary Committee to revise and report at next meeting. seconded by Brinker and Carried.
