Love offered the following resolution and moved its adoption.

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Alliance Ohio that the Contract entered into by and between the City of Alliance Ohio and the Alliance Water Works Company on the 7th day of December 1891 be modified so as to allow the said Alliance Water Works Company to erect the stand pipe referred to in said Contract on the summit of Haugh's Hill near the north line of the sixth ward instead of in the sixth ward as provided in said Contract. This resolution shall take effect on the acceptance of this modification by the said Alliance Water Works Company and this resolution shall not be construed to change the said Contract in any respect except as to the location

of said stand pipe"

Buck seconded the motion to adopt. The yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Buck Leowan Combauk Devine Gabelle Jenkins Love Wilson Yeas 8 nays 0 and the resolution was declared adopted

A Resolution to register bonds was read as follows: "Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Alliance Ohio. That refunding bonds of the city of Alliance numbered from 899. to 923. both inclusive. dated March 5. 1892 be registered at the request of Lamprecht Bros & Co of Cleveland Ohio the owners of said bonds. in the Bond record of the City of Alliance in the name of the trustees of the Firemen's Pension fund of the city of Cleveland Ohio in accordance with the provisions of sec. 11 of an act of the 69th general assembly of the state of Ohio creating and establishing said Board of Trustees and passed April 11. 1890."

Jenkins moved the adoption of the resolution seconded by Love. The yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Buck Leowan Combauk Devine Gabelle Jenkins Love Wilson. Yeas 8 nays none and the resolution was declared adopted.

Devine offered the following report of the police Committee:

To the president and city Council. As your Committee on police would respectfully recommend that in the absence of a report from the finance Committee as to the amount to be appropriated to the police fund that until such time as this information be furnished to your Committee that the Mayor be authorized to hire two policemen at a salary of \$67⁰⁰ per month

The roll was then called on the Confirmation of William Beardley resulting Yeas Cowan Crumbaugh Drovin Gabele. Nays Buck Love Wilson. Yeas 4 nays 3. and the nomination was declared rejected. The Mayor then presented the name of John Votaw. and on motion of Love action on the same was deferred until the next meeting. The Mayor then presented the name of G. R. Gyger for City Civil engineer and the roll was called resulting Yeas 8 nays 0. and Mr Gyger was declared confirmed. Council then adjourned
