

Alliance Ohio May 16th 1892

Council met in regular session with president Wilson presiding and the following members present Brinker Bush Buck Combaugh Devine Jenkins Gabel Lane Abbott Cowan, Carley, Kaylen.

The minutes of preceding meetings were read and approved.

A petition for the opening of Seneca Street from Grant Street to Wilmer was read and referred to the street committee

On motion of Brinker the Clerk was instructed to notify trustees of Churches on improved streets to pay their assessments

Low called attention to water overflowing Linden Avenue at Cambridge Street and the same was referred to the street committee.

Bush called attention to the fact of parties tearing up improved streets in digging cellar drains &c and moved the matter be referred to the Judiciary Committee to provide means to prevent

The question of providing Catch basin covers for the catch basins on Patterson Street was on motion of Gabel referred to the street committee with power to act.

The water committee made the following report. The undersigned members of the water committee would recommend that a change be made in the location of one fire plug and that the same be changed from the intersection of South Liberty Street and Grant Street to the intersection of South Liberty Ave and Wilmer Streets as we believe the change if made will be for the best interests of all the property in that locality as well as the South Liberty Ave improvement signed W B Combaugh A.
