An Ordinance to levy a special tax of one mill on all the taxable property of the city except the ~~first~~ sixth ward was read and Brinker moved the same be placed on its passage seconded by Love and carried yeas Brinker Buck Bush Gable Jenkins Love Wilson Yeas 7 nays 0
