

Alliance Ohio July 18. 1892

Council met in regular session with president Wilson in the chair and the following members present - Brinker Buck Bush ~~Shuman~~ Crubrough Drvine Carley Gubelle Junkins L Snyder Love Absent Cowan

Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

Bill of Election Board

A bill against the city in favor of the County board of Elections for \$2300 for Tickets and Poll Books furnished for the Spring election was presented and

on motion of Brinker the Clerk was instructed to collect \$500 from the Board of Education and \$500 from the Lexington Township Trustees as their portion of said bill.

Names of Jurors

A list of 144 names of electors suitable to serve as Jurors in the Mayor's Court - was submitted and Brinker moved the same be approved. seconded by Drvine and Carried.

Petition to repeal Prohibitory Ordinance

A petition was read asking that the question of the repeal of the prohibitory Ordinance be submitted to the voters of the City and on motion of Brinker the same was received and ordered placed on file

The committee appointed to consider the propositions of certain parties convicted of selling liquor to settle asked for further time and on motion of Snyder the same was granted

Brinker submitted the following resolution and moved its adoption

That the tickets shall have printed or written thereon the words

Sec 3. That at the same election there be submitted to the qualified voters of said city the question whether or not the prohibitory Ordinance now in force in said city should be repealed. That the tickets shall have printed or written thereon the words

Sec 4 That notice of said special election shall be given at least ten days prior to the holding of the same in two newspapers in said city and that the Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to prepare said notice and have the same published as aforesaid.

The street committee submitted the following: Whereas complaint has been filed with the street committee that the mill property on prospect street has been and is being damaged by water and whereas the street committee after investigating the situation find that the water running north on the west side of Arch street is the cause of the greater part of the damages spoken of we therefore recommend the following resolution:

Be it resolved that it is the sense of this council that the street committee have the water on Arch street carried north to the P. F. W & C R.R. by having a catch basin built at the corner of Arch and prospect streets and that the pipe required for the above mentioned work be taken from the Buck street sewer.

Petition

The street committee to whom was referred the petition for the improvement of Market street by paving from Arch to Union Avenue reported favorably toward granting the same and recommended that the Council act favorably on the petition provided that said street be first put to grade before any earth is used to fill private property. and on motion of Brinker seconded by Bush the report was adopted.

Band Stand

Bush offered a resolution to remove the Band Stand from the public square to the City Lot west of the City Hall. and on motion of Brinker it was amended so as to remove said band stand without designating to where. The yeas and nays were called on the adoption of the resolution as amended resulting Yeas Brinker Bush Lambough Jankeles Kayler ~~Lowe~~ Wilson Nays Buck Devine Gubelle Earley Lowe yeas 6 nays 5 and the motion was declared lost.

Catch Basin

Kayler moved that the procuring of screens or coverings for the catch basins at the cor. of Main and Arch streets be referred to the street committee with power to act. seconded by Brinker and carried Yeas 11 nays 0.

Repair Alley
on Patterson
Street

Attention was called to the necessity of some work to be done at the alley East of north Liberty Street and corner of Patterson Street and on motion of Devine the same was referred to the street committee with power to act. seconded by Brinker and carried Yeas 11 nays 0.

& Trustees
to Confer

On Motion of Brinker seconded by Buck the street committee was instructed to confer with the township trustees with reference to keeping South Liberty Street in repair.

Sidewalk over
Fowls run

The repair of the sidewalk on Patterson Street over the run was on motion of Lowe referred back to the sidewalk committee.

Engineer
set grade
stakes

On Motion of Kayler the engineer was instructed to set grade stakes for sidewalks for Geo Hampton on South Union Avenue. Wm Jandis Hester Ave and Jasse Hampton on Noble street.

Water Main
on 11th st

The report of the water committee on the petition for water main on 11th street was taken from the table (having been tabled at the preceding meeting) and the yeas and nays called on the adoption of the report.

resulting yeas Buck Bush Cornbough Early Jenkins Kayler Love Wilson Nays Drinker Devine Gabelle yeas 8 nays 9 and the report was declared adopted.

Water fountain
in 2nd Ward

Devine stated that certain parties in the second ward desired a watering fountain at the corner of Kebb and Patterson streets and moved that the clerk be instructed to ascertain from the water works company the cost &c for the same.

M Duchers
Case

The Mayor called attention of Council to the case of the City vs M. Doucher who had been convicted for violating the prohibitory ordinance and asked whether it was the desire of Council to have the sentence executed and on motion of Kayler it was referred to the committee on Superior Cases

Ely st
Grade ord

An Ordinance to amend the grade on Ely Street was read 3^d time and Bush moved the final passage of the same seconded by Buck. The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Drinker Buck Bush Cornbough Devine Gabelle Jenkins Kayler Love Wilson yeas 10 nays 0 and the ordinance was declared passed.

Freedom
st Grade

An Ordinance to amend the grade on South Freedom Avenue was read first time and on motion of Love seconded by Bush yeas 10 nays 0 the rules were suspended and the Ordinance read second time by Tittle and on motion of Love seconded by

Bush yeas 10 nays 0 The rules were again suspended and the ordinance was read third time and Love moved the same be placed on its final passage seconded by Kayler the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Brinker Buck Bush Crumbaugh Devine Gabelle Jenkins Kayler Love Wilson yeas 10 nays 0 and the Ordinance was declared passed.

Noble Street Grade Ordinance

An Ordinance to establish a grade on Noble street was read first time and on motion of Bush seconded by Brinker yeas 10 nays 0 the rules were suspended and the ordinance read second time by title and on motion of Brinker the rules were again suspended yeas 10 nays 0 and the ordinance read third time and vote called on final passage resulting yeas Brinker Buck Crumbaugh Devine Gabelle Jenkins Kayler Love Wilson yeas 9 nays 0 and the ordinance was declared passed.

Engineer set stakes on Ely Street

On motion of Love seconded by Bush yeas 10 nays 0 the Engineer was instructed to set grade stakes on Ely Street.

Accept Hadley Bid on Ely

Jenkins Moved that the bid of John Hadley be accepted for the improvement of Ely street. Carried yeas Brinker Buck Bush Crumbaugh Gabelle Jenkins Kayler Love Wilson Noy Devine yeas 9 nays 0.

Hadley to go to work on Ely st

Bush moved that Mr Jno Hadley be permitted to get to work on Ely street seconded by Jenkins and Carried. Yeas Buck Bush Crumbaugh Jenkins Kayler Love Wilson. Nays Brinker yeas 7 nays 1. No further business Council adjourned.
