

Alliance Ohio August 1st 1892

Council met in regular session with president Wilson presiding and the following members present. Brinker Buck Bush Orubaugh Devine Gabele Jenkins Kayler Love absent Cowan and Barley.

The minutes of preceding meeting read and approved. The Mayor's report of \$101.50 being collected for fines and Licenses for the month of July was read, accepted and ordered placed on file.

A petition to open Forest Street was presented and referred to the Street Committee

Brinker of the finance Committee reported as having made a careful and thorough examination of the books, vouchers and bills ~~of~~ with reference to the amount yet due the

Water Works Company for Hydrant rental under the old contract and reported that under said contract the city had received service to the amount of \$27375⁰⁰ and had paid the company \$26644⁰⁰ leaving a balance yet due of \$731⁰⁰ and reported a bill for the same and Bush moved the same be allowed and paid. seconded by Buck and carried yeas. Brinker, Buck, Bush, Orubaugh, Devine,

Gabele Jenkins, Kayler Love Wilson yeas 10 nays 0

A number of bills against the city for the month of July having been approved by the proper committees were read and an ordinance ordered prepared providing for their payment. on motion of

Brinker there was apportioned from the unapportioned fund to the Street fund \$75⁰⁰

The Claims ordinance was then read and

Bush moved the same be placed on its passage seconded by Brinker and carried yeas 10 nays 0.

Brinker moved that the Street Committee confer with the County Commissioners with reference to widening the Bridge across the run on Ely Street East of Union Avenue and that any expense attached to the same be charged to the Ely Street improvement. seconded by Jenkins and carried.

A resolution declaring it necessary to improve Market Street was read as follows: Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Alliance Ohio that it is hereby declared necessary to improve Market Street from Arch Avenue west to Union Avenue by putting the same to the established grade paving the roadway with paving brick or or other suitable material setting curb and gutter stones and constructing the necessary culverts and drains in accordance with plans and profiles on file in the office of the city clerk. The cost and expense of said improvement shall be assessed per foot front on the lots and lands abutting thereon. The said assessments shall be payable in five annual installments and bonds shall be issued in anticipation of the collection of such assessments. and the city clerk is hereby directed to cause this resolution to be published for two weeks in a newspaper published and of general circulation in the corporation and George McFarland city Marshal is hereby appointed to serve notice of the passage of this resolution on the owners of property which abuts on said improvement.

by Love and Carried. Brinker moved that
the resolution be laid on the table without
day seconded by Bush and Carried.

it was agreed that when Council adjourns it
be to meet Monday evening Aug 8 1892.
