Petition of Solid
 Steel Co to vacate
 Streets & Alleys

A Petition to vacate streets and alleys in
 a portion of Highland Park addition signed
 by Mrs Anna and Harry Waugh was referred
 to the Street Committee

Petition to remove
 Band Stand

A Petition to remove the Band
 Stand from the public square was also
 referred to the Street Committee

Bridge on
 Hester ave.
 referred

Bush reported the bridge on Hester
 Avenue near the intersection ~~with~~ of Hester Ave
 and Patterson Street in bad condition
 and Buck reported the bridge west of Hancock
 Shop needing some repairs. and Kayler moved
 they be referred to the street committee with
 Power to act seconded by Jenkins and
 Lost Yeas 3 nays 7. The matter was then
 on motion of Kayler referred to the Street
 and Sewerage Committee to investigate
 and report.

Sewers along
 railroad

Bush called attention to the
 condition of the sewer along the south side
 of the P. F. W. R.R. between Arch and Freedom
 streets and stated that if the city would
 furnish $\frac{1}{4}$ the tile necessary the R.R. Co would
 furnish the balance and do the work of
 constructing a tile sewer between said points

Kayler also called attention to the sewer or
 ditch along the C & P Track south of the
 crossing being in bad condition, and
 on motion of Brinker seconded by
 Jenkins they were both referred to the
 Street Committee to confer with R.R. Co
 and report the ~~probable~~ probable cost &c
 at next meeting.

necessity of some work being done on the streets in the 6th ward viz: Union ave and east State Street and Kayler moved be referred to the Street Committee seconded by Bush and lost yeas & nays 6. The same was then on motion of Love seconded by Brinker referred to the Judiciary Committee

To grant F.E.
Hartzell time to
lay sidewalk

Bush reported that F.E. Hartzell wished an extension of time in which to construct a sidewalk in front of his property on North Union Avenue and on motion of Bush the same was referred to the sidewalk Committee.

Hussey Wells
sidewalk

The Clerk reported having collected \$135⁰⁰ for the Hussey Wells sidewalk on West Main Street and that Mr Myers the agent for the property had retained \$3²¹ of the bill and claimed the walk had not been properly constructed and would pay the balance when the walk was put in proper condition. The matter was referred to the sidewalk Committee and Bush reported that the defect in the walk was caused by driving coal wagons on the same and was in no way the fault of the city and recommended the collection of the full amount on motion of Love the report was accepted.

To change location
of Hydrant on
Union Ave

Brinker called attention to the location of a Hydrant on Union Avenue the same having been ordered located at the south line of the Pettit property and it was deemed advisable to have it located farther north and the water committee was instructed to attend to the same.

Cemetery Com
to collect money
due for lots

Gabelle reported that the Cemetery Trustees held a number of notes which had been given in payment for cemetery lots in years past and which had never been paid and asked that some action be taken in the matter and on motion of Bush seconded

by Kayler the same was referred to the Cemetery Committee and Solicitor with power to act

Passage of Ordinance to appropriate land to open Summit-st

An Ordinance to appropriate for street purposes certain lands therein described (said lands being. C & P. R. R lands on East Summit Street) was read Third time and Bush moved the final passage of the same seconded by Kayler. The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Brinker, ^{Buck} Bush, Crubough, Earley, Gable, Jenkins, Kayler, Love, Wilson yeas 10 Nays 0 and the ordinance was declared passed.

report of committee on S Webb st.

The committee appointed to confer with Mr Auld with reference to the opening of South Webb Street reported that Mr Auld had agreed that he would open the street through his land some time next spring provided that a reasonable grade was established thereon.

third reading of ordinance to appropriate land on Webb st lost

An Ordinance to appropriate for street purposes certain land therein described and being through Mr Auld's lands for the opening of South Webb Street was read Third time and Brinker moved the same be placed on its passage seconded by Bush the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Brinker, Bush, Jenkins, Kayler, Nays, Buck, Crubough, Devine, Earley, Gable, Love, Wilson. yeas 4 nays 7 and the ordinance was declared lost

Petition to pave Ash st

A Petition to improve Ash Street from Liberty Street to the C & P. R. R by grading, draining and paving and reading as follows: was presented:

The undersigned hereby represent that it is necessary to improve Ash Street from the west side of the C & P. R. R to the east side of Liberty Avenue in this City by grading, draining, curbing and paving the same constructing the necessary crosswalks and being the owners of more than than two thirds part front bounding and abutting on said improvement we hereby petition for said improvement and

request the same to be speedily constructed and that the costs and expenses of the same be levied and assessed upon the abutting lands as your honorable body may determine

And in consideration of the said City Council granting this petition we each of us severally agree to hold the said city free from any expense by any property being valued on the tax duplicate to low to discharge and pay our full share of the cost of said improvement and in consideration as aforesaid we do hereby severally expressly waive all our Statutory rights and privileges relating to the limitations of the city's power to assess in such cases to 25% of the ~~total~~ value of the property as assessed for taxation as provided in Section 2270 R.S. of Ohio signed

On Motion of Kayler seconded by Bush the above petition was referred to the Street Committee and on Motion of Bush the matter of establishing a grade on said Ash Street was referred to the grade Committee to report at next meeting.
