A communication from C. E. Scranton
Superintendent of the Alliance and Northern and
L. E. A & S Ry's asking permission to lay a side
track on Mechanic Street on the west side of the
~~West~~ Main track from above Columbia Street
to Market Street. and agreeing in consideration of
the same being granted to fill in over the sewer
a sufficient space for the side track and a
public driveway along the side of the same from
Market to Columbia Street, was on motion of
Brinker referred to the Street Committee to report
at their earliest convenience.

Park

The Street Committee to whom had been
referred the petition to vacate certain streets and
alleys in Highland Park Addition reported
as follows: "We the Committee on Streets to
whom was referred the petition from the representatives
of the Waugh Estate by leave to report in
favor of the Council granting the same"
signed C. A. Bush R. S. Kayler. and on motion
of Love the report was adopted and on
motion of Bush the Clerk was instructed to
advertise the same according to law.

employment
of Sanitary
policeman

The Committee to whom had been referred
the matter of employing a sanitary policeman
recommended through the Chairman. Mr Devine
that there be a policeman employed under
the present laws and Ordinance providing
for the appointment policeman and that he be
detailed to act in the capacity of Sanitary policeman
and that he be employed for one month at
the regular salary of \$50⁰⁰ per month with
the understanding that if at the expiration one
month it was considered necessary he should
be retained so long as his services were
needed and on motion of Bush

seconded by Kayler the report was adopted. Brinker offered a resolution to extend the water main on Arch Street from Eleventh Street south to South Street. and moved its adoption seconded by Buck and lost. Yeas Brinker Buck Kayler Love Wilson. Nays Bush Cowan Devine. Yeas 5 nays 3

The Street Committee to whom had been referred the petition of the Ely Street property owners. at the preceding meeting. asking that the macadamizing of said Ely Street be postponed reported as follows:

"We the Committee on Streets to whom was referred the petition ~~on~~ from Ely Street property owners would report that (after securing legal advice) no action should be taken by the Council annulling the former legislation for the improvement of Ely Street." Signed: W. Bush R. J. Kayler

Brinker moved the adoption of the report seconded by Love. The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Brinker Bush Kayler Wilson. Nays Buck Cowan Devine Love. Yeas 4 nays 4. and the motion was declared lost.

The Committee ^{appointed} to act with the board of Health and to recommend a suitable person to act as sanitary policeman recommended William Anderson and Mayor Excell presented his name to Council and Bush moved the same be confirmed. The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Brinker Buck Bush Cowan Devine Kayler Love Wilson. Yeas 5 nays 0 and the nomination was declared confirmed.

Love moved that the petition of Ely Street property owners praying that the macadamizing of said street be deferred. be granted seconded by Cowan

The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas
 Cowan Drove Love. Nays Brinker Buck
 Bush Kayler Wilson yeas 3 nays 5. and the
 motion was declared lost

An Ordinance to vacate portion of
 An Alley. being an alley lying between Liberty
 and Seneca Avenues. and running from Oxford
 Street south to the first Alley south of and
 parallel with Oxford Street was read first
 time. An Ordinance
 to vacate a portion of Harrison Street was
 read first time.

On motion of Kayler the Clerk
 was instructed to notify the Penna R.R. Co. to
 lay a sidewalk along their property on North
 Freedom Street.

On Motion Council adjourned
