Council met in adjourned session with President Wilson presiding and the following members present
 Brinker Bush Cowan Crumbaugh
 Dwin Earley Kayler Love
 Absent Buck Gabel Jenkins.

On Motion of Love the reading of the minutes was dispensed with.

Motion to settle
 Liquor cases

In the matter of the Liquor Cases against Jno Loftis, Jno Bissler and Nancy Joyce, against whom fines had been imposed for violation of the prohibitory Ordinance and not having been collected Brinker moved that the city accept fifty cents on the dollar or one half of the fines imposed on condition that the said Loftis, Bissler and Joyce pay the same within one week and also pay all costs in said cases. seconded by Bush.

Love moved to amend by striking out the cases of Loftis and Bissler seconded by Kayler and carried. The yeas and nays were called on the motion as amended resulting yeas Brinker Bush Cowan Crumbaugh Earley Kayler Love Wilson. Yeas 8 nays 0 and the motion as amended was declared carried.

On Motion of Brinker seconded by Kayler the street committee was instructed to repair the bridge on Hester Avenue. Yeas 8 nays 0

On motion of Bush seconded by Love the street committee was instructed to have plank put on the bridge on Keystone Street near David Beck's. yeas 8 nays 0

A resolution to contract with John Hadley for the improvement of Ely Street from Park Street west to the Corporation Line was read and Love moved

The same be adopted. seconded by Kayler.

The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Brinker Bush Leubaugh Jenkins Love Wilson but before the result was announced Bush changed his vote to nay. and the vote stood yeas 5 nays one. (Cowan and Curley refusing to vote.) and the motion was declared lost.

Brinker moved that the Street Committee and Engineer be instructed to make an estimate of the cost of a rail road crossing across Oxford Street and report the same at next meeting. seconded by Kayler The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Brinker Bush Cowan Leubaugh Kayler Love Wilson nay Curley. Yeas 7 nays 1. and the motion was declared carried.

On motion of Bush seconded by Brinker the matter of opening Trout Street was referred to the Street Committee

On Motion of Bush seconded by Kayler the Clerk was instructed to furnish the Sidewalk Committee with a list of sidewalks ordered by resolution of which notice had been served on the property owners and which have not been laid.

On Motion of Bush seconded by Kayler the matter of providing better fire protection for the Eastern portion of the Third Ward was referred to the Water Committee

A petition from J. D. Weybrecht and Sons asking for the Extension of the Water Main on East Broadway was read and on motion of Love referred to the Water Committee with instructions to report as soon as possible.

On Motion of Kayler seconded by Bush the Grade Committee was instructed to report a new grade for Wayne Street. yeas 8 nays 0
