

Alliance Ohio Oct 3. 1842

Council met in regular session with President Wilson presiding and the following members present: Brinker Buck-Bush Cowan Emburyh Devine Earley Gabel Kayler Love. Absent Jenkins.

The minutes of preceding meetings read and approved.

The Mayor's report for the months of August and September. Showing fines and licenses collected in August \$148<sup>25</sup> and September \$226<sup>00</sup> was read and on motion of Devine accepted and ordered placed on file.

A Petition from residents of Ely Street and Vicinity asking that the water main be extended on said street from the present terminus west to the Corporation Line was read and on motion of Brinker seconded by Buck referred to the water committee with instructions to report during the session.

A Petition from the Solid Steel Company asking that the water main on East Broadway be extended 830 feet east from the present terminus and the ~~location~~ of two Hydrants instead of one as arranged through the petition of J. T. Weybrecht. was read and on motion of Devine ~~to~~ seconded by Kayler was referred to the Water Committee to report ~~at~~ during the session.

Mr William Speaker called attention of Council to a lot of rubbish being piled up against the end of his building by the occupants of the Reeves building which he desired to have removed. and on motion of Kayler seconded by Devine the matter was referred to the committee of fire wardens.

Brinker of the finance committee reported having bills for the fiscal estimate on South Liberty and

The bill of Robt Auld being for \$1631<sup>10</sup> and of M Macauley for \$1546<sup>77</sup>. also a bill for \$600<sup>00</sup> as the first estimate for the Ely street Contract in favor of John Hadley, and moved that the bills of Robert Auld and M Macauley be approved for one thousand dollars each. ~~and bill of John~~ seconded by Bush. The yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Brinker Bush Brown Crumbaugh Divine Carley Gabele Love Wilson Nays Bush Kayler. Yeas 9 nays 2. and the motion was declared carried.

The <sup>Street</sup> committee made the following We the undersigned members of the street committee beg leave to report John Auld and Sons as Contractors for Liberty Avenue improvement no 2 have completed their contract to the entire satisfaction of the committee" signed C.H. Bush R.S. Kayler W.B. Crumbaugh. and G.R. Gyger city engineer.

Bush moved that the vote on the motion to adopt the resolution to contract with John Hadley be reconsidered seconded by Kayler. The yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Brinker Bush Bush Crumbaugh Divine Gabele Kayler Love Wilson. Nays Carley and Cowan. Yeas 9 nays 2. and the motion was declared carried.

The resolution was then read as follows: Be it resolved by the Council of the city of Alliance Ohio that the bid of John Hadley for the improvement of Ely Street from the east side of Park Street west to the Corporation line be accepted the same being the lowest in the aggregate for said work and that the Mayor is hereby authorized and instructed to enter into a contract on behalf of the Corporation with the said John Hadley with M.C. Barber and W.H. Brown as sureties for doing said work according to the plans and specifications therefor at the following rates to wit:

Adoption of above resolution.

The yeas and nays were then called on the Original Motion to adopt the above resolution resulting Yeas Brinker Bush Bush Crubaugh Devine Gable Kayler Love Wilson. Nays Cowan Earley. Yeas 9 nays 2 and the resolution was declared adopted.

Appointment of Committee to take care of Water on Ely St.

Earley stated his objection to the adoption of the resolution as being that it would bring too much water from the west for the stream east of Union Avenue to carry away and Devine moved the matter be referred to the street committee seconded by Love. Brinker moved to amend and substitute the Judiciary Committee, seconded by Devine. Bush moved to amend by striking out the Judiciary Committee and substituting Earley and Cowan as the said Committee. after some discussion the motion to refer to the Judiciary Committee was carried.

Hadley's Estimate allowed

On motion of Brinker seconded by Bush the bill of John Hadley for \$600<sup>00</sup> as the first Estimate for the Ely Street Contract was approved.

Resolution to

Brinker offered the following resolution  
and moved its adoption. "Resolved by the  
city council that the city solicitor is hereby  
authorized and directed to settle the case of  
the city of Alliance vs Mary Bissler and Frances  
Moore on the payment by them of the sum of  
\$200<sup>00</sup> and out of the same the said  
solicitor is directed to pay the costs in said  
case and the balance pay into the city treasury.

Divine seconded the motion to adopt. The yeas  
and nays were called resulting yeas Brinker  
Buck Bush Cowan Crubanyh Divine Earley  
Gabele Kayler Love Wilson Yeas 11 nays 0  
and the resolution was declared adopted.

Free Fair

Mr Samuel Kutzenstein on behalf  
of the business men desiring to have a free  
fair asked permission of Council to have the  
usual privileges granted for the same and  
Kayler moved the permission be granted with  
such restrictions as Council may deem advisable,  
The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas  
Bush Divine Kayler Wilson. Nays Brinker.  
Buck, Cowan, Crubanyh, Earley, Gabele, Love  
Yeas 4 nays 7, and the motion was declared  
lost.

The Street Committee made the following  
report on the amount of money necessary to clean  
up the streets and alleys as ordered as a sanitary  
measure.

The Street Committee to whom  
was referred the question of reporting the  
amount of funds that would be  
required to pay the expenses of cleaning  
up the streets and alleys beg leave to

report that it is the opinion of the undersigned that \$950<sup>00</sup> will be required to do the work and we therefor recommend that the finance committee be instructed to take such steps as may be necessary to secure the amount named." signed C. H. Bush R. S. Kayler and W. B. Crumbaugh.

Adoption of above report

Kayler moved the adoption of the report seconded by Brinker and carried Yeas Brinker Bush Buck Cowan Crumbaugh Drvine Earley Gable Kayler Love Wilson Yeas 11 nays 0.

Report of Committee on Estimate of Cost of R. R. Crossing on Oxford st

The committee to whom had been referred the matter of making an estimate of the cost of the approach to the railroad crossing on Oxford Street reported as follows:

"The committee on Streets ~~and alleys~~ beg leave to report favorable on the proposition from property owners on Oxford Street and we the undersigned recommend that the city pay one half the cost of the proposed improvement. The Engineer's estimated cost of said improvement being six hundred and thirty dollars (\$630<sup>00</sup>)" signed C. H. Bush R. S. Kayler. W. B. Crumbaugh

The motion to lay on the table was declared lost and the yeas and nays called on the motion to adopt resulting yeas Brinker Bush Cowan Bush Crumbaugh Kayler Love Wilson Nays Drvine Earley Gable Yeas 8 nays 3 and the report was declared adopted

Brinker moved that the Street Committee furnish the tile necessary for a sewer across south Seneca Street South of Summit Street if the property owners would put the street to grade seconded by Bush and carried Yeas Brinker Bush Bush Leubayh Gabele Love Wilson Nay Divine Yeas 7 nays 1.

On motion of Bush seconded by Brinker it was agreed that when council adjourn it be to meet Monday evening Oct 10:

On motion of Love seconded by Brinker it was agreed that Council meet on Thursday Oct 6<sup>th</sup> to inspect the South Liberty and South Arch Avenue improvements.

To Grant L. E. & J. R. Reo

right of way for sidetrack

Brinker moved that the L. E. & J. R. Reo be granted the right of way for a sidetrack on Mechanic Street between Market and Columbia on condition that said R R Co put said Mechanic Street to grade between the above mentioned points and for a distance of 20 feet in width west of said sidetrack. seconded by Love and carried. Yeas Brinker Bush Bush Leubayh Gabele Love Wilson. Yeas 7 nays 0. and on motion of Brinker seconded by Bush the Street Committee and Solicitor were instructed to prepare an Ordinance providing for the grant of said right of way on the above conditions
