R. with a view to arrange with said officials to lower and extend the iron pipes running parallel with the C & P. R. R. to the south side of Ash Street and that any expense incurred in making such arrangement be paid from the Ash Street improvement fund. The Committee to report figures at next meeting of Council.

Brinker seconded the adoption of the resolution the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Brinker Buck Bush Cowan Devine Early Gable Jenkins Love Wilson Yeas 10 nays 0. and the resolution was declared adopted.
