

Council Chamber Alliance Ohio Oct 31 1892

Council met in adjourned session with president Wilson in the Chair and the following members present. Brinker Buck Bush Irvine ~~Casey~~ Gabele Jenkins Kayler Love. Absent Keranbaugh Leonard Easley

An invitation from the president and secretary of the free fair association to Council to attend a banquet at the Arlington Hotel, <sup>at 9:15 P.M.</sup> was on motion of Bush accepted.

Petition to defer grading Noble st

A Petition from property owners on Noble Street asking that the proposed grading of said Noble Street be postponed until next Spring was referred to the Street Committee to report during the session

Resolution to employ W<sup>m</sup> Anderson permanently

Brinker offered the following resolution and moved its adoption. Resolved by the Council of the City of Alliance Ohio that the services of W<sup>m</sup> Anderson as Sanitary Officer be continued on condition that one half of his time be used as day policeman and resolved that the Finance Committee be and are hereby instructed to provide funds out of the unappropriated funds to pay said officer's salary.

Gabele seconded the motion to adopt the resolution. The yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Brinker Buck Bush Gabele Jenkins Kayler Love Wilson Yeas 8 nays 0. and the resolution was declared adopted.

Resolution to authorize Cantine to sell fire engine lost

Brinker offered a resolution to authorize Mr W. W. Cantine to sell the fire engine and moved the same be adopted. seconded by Buck.

Kayler stated that he had been negotiating for the sale of the Engine and had some prospects of disposing of it. and the resolution ~~to~~ was then ~~lost~~ <sup>lost</sup> voted on and lost. yeas 0 nays 8.

Water Works Co to repair streets

A resolution requiring the Water Works Company to repair and restore to ~~the~~ same condition as it was before they dug it up to lay their mains. Union Ave from Rosenberry to State Street and providing that if not complied with in ten days from service of order then the city do the work at the expense of said water works Co. was read

and Knupler moved its adoption seconded  
by Brinker and carried Yeas 8 nays 0

On motion of Brinker the Clerk was  
instructed to notify the Street Committee  
when the time given said water works  
company to fix the above streets expired

Rosenberg was on motion of Davis referred  
to the Sewer Committee.

Report of Committee  
on Noble at  
Grade

The Street Committee to whom was  
referred the petition to defer the grading of  
Noble street made the following  
report. We the undersigned members  
of the Street Committee having examined

The condition of the street mentioned in the within  
~~named~~ petition beg leave to report that it is our  
 opinion that the work of grading Noble Street should  
 proceed without delay and would therefore recommend  
 the same be done. signed L H Bush, R S Kayler  
 and on motion of Bush seconded by  
 Devine the report was adopted.

Bush then offered the following resolution and moved  
 its adoption. "Be it resolved that it is the sense of  
 this Council that the Street Committee be and is hereby  
 instructed to arrange with the Board of Education to  
 put Noble Street to grade provided that said Board of  
 education agree to pay the expense of hauling"  
 Kayler seconded the motion to adopt. The yeas and nays  
 were called, resulting yeas Brinker, Buck Bush  
 Devine Gable Jenkins Kayler Love Wilson  
 yeas 9 nays 0. and the resolution was declared  
 adopted.

Attention was called to a nuisance  
 existing on the lots formerly occupied by the Star  
 planing mill at the corner of Mechanic and  
 Prospect Streets in the shape of an excavation  
 being filled with filthy water and on motion  
 of Bush seconded by Kayler yeas 9 nays 0 the  
 same was referred to the Special Sanitary  
 Committee with power to act.

The matter of having College Street west  
 of Arch put to grade was on motion of  
 Brinker referred to the street committee.

On motion of Bush the Clerk was  
 instructed to notify the water works Co  
 to stop leakage in their mains at the corner  
 of Summit and Mechanic Streets and at the  
 corner of Liberty and Summit.

The Water Committee to whom had been  
 referred the petition of the Solid Steel Co for an  
 extension of the water main on east Broadway  
 reported as follows: "We the Water Committee beg  
 leave to report favorably on the above petition"  
 signed W. B. Crumblyl A B Love L H Bush  
 P A Gable. Love moved the report  
 be adopted seconded by Bush. and

Love moved that the Clerk be instructed to  
issue an Order to the water works company  
to extend the main in accordance with the said  
petition and report thereon and to locate on Plug  
or Hydrant as the water committee may direct,  
seconded by Gabele and Carried Yeas Brinker  
Duck Bush Devine Gabele Jenkins Kayler  
Love Wilson. Yeas 9 nays 0

The Water Committee to whom had been  
referred the petition for the extension of the Water  
mains on Ely Street from the present terminus  
west to the corporation line reported as follows:

" We the water committee beg leave to report  
unfavorably on the above petition" signed  
H. B. Crubaugh. C. H. Bush. A. B. Love  
P. A. Gabele. on motion of Devine seconded  
by Gabele the report was adopted.

" E. H. Brosius then addressed Council and  
asked that the water main on Ely Street be  
extended west from the present terminus  
sufficient distance for one Hydrant and  
stated that he would guarantee the payment  
to the water works company <sup>rental</sup> for said Hydrant  
for one year and without cost to the city  
for that time.

Jenkins moved that the request be granted  
" Kayler moved to amend by ordering  
the Clerk to issue an order to the Water  
works Company to extend the main and locate  
one plug on Ely Street and also extend the main  
from Arch on Eleventh Street ~~the~~ distance for  
one Hydrant and locate the same at  
corner of Eleventh Street and Highland ave.  
<sup>see by Love</sup>

" Devine moved to amend by including  
the extension of the main and locating  
a Hydrant near the new school House  
in the second ward as the water committee  
may direct. <sup>see by Gabele carried</sup> The yeas and nays  
were then called on the motion as  
amended. resulting yeas

Brinker Buck Bush Devine Gabelle Jenkins Kayler  
Love Wilson. Yeas 9 nays 0. and the motion was  
declared carried.

On Motion of Brinker the water committee was  
instructed to ascertain the time the said plugs are  
located and the date at which they commence drawing  
rent and file the same with the clerk

Prust Marsh of the Mt Union College asked Council  
to establish grades on streets in the College Campus  
addition. and on Motion of Bush seconded by Jenkins  
yeas 9 nays 0. The grade committee and Engineer  
were instructed to report grade ordinances for  
the same.

An Ordinance to vacate a portion  
of an Alley. and being that part of the first alley  
west of and parallel with South Liberty Avenue lying  
between Oxford Street and the first alley south of and  
parallel with Oxford Street. was read Third time  
and Bush moved the same be placed on its passage  
seconded by Kayler and carried yeas Brinker Buck  
Bush Devine Gabelle Jenkins Kayler Love Wilson  
yeas 9 nays 0

An Ordinance to Vacate ten feet of  
the north side of Harrison street was read  
Third time and on Motion of Love seconded by  
Devine laid on the table for one week.

On Motion of Love seconded by Brinker a vote of thanks  
was tendered the Fine Fair Committee for their invitation  
to the Banquet

A Petition signed by Geo R Thomas  
and Ben J. Lewis asking for the vacation of part  
of an Alley. beginning on the south side of East  
Cambridge Street between South Morgan and South  
Webb Avenues and running south to the north  
side of the first Alley running parallel with  
Cambridge street was referred to the street  
Committee.
