The special committee to whom had
 been referred the proposition of Lucy S. Weaver
 with reference to lowering the sidewalk on Linden
 avenue along the East side of her property reported
 that the proposition had been modified by Mr
 D. Dording as her representative in so far
 that if the City would place the sidewalk on the
 non established grade. ~~that~~ it would be satisfactory
 to her and she would relinquish any and all
 claims for damages which she might have by reason
 of the change of grade in making the recent
 improvement. and Love moved the report
 be adopted seconded by Buck and carried
 Yeas Brinker Buck Bush Cowan Crubugh
 Devine Early Jenkins Love Wilson Yeas 10
 Nays none. and on motion of Brinker seconded
 by Love the same Committee was instructed to
 enter into a written agreement with the said

Wilson moved the bill be allowed and be placed in an Ordinance providing for its payment. seconded by Jenkins. The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Brinker Buck Bush Crubbaugh Jenkins Love Wilson Nays Devine Early Cowan Gabele. Yeas 7 nays 4.

and the motion was declared carried. ~~Brinker~~ of the finance committee reported having approved a number of bills, and presented the bills of A. F. Wicks for repairing horse wagon ~~and~~ which was referred to the fire committee and the bill of the Street R R Co for street lighting for November which was referred to a committee consisting of Jenkins Love Brinker and Crubbaugh.

Bill of Kayler

The bills approved were read, and Brinker presented a bill of R. S. Kayler for \$150⁶⁵ for balance due on the sewer built along the south side of the P. & W. R R. which the City had agreed to pay and moved the same be allowed and be placed in the claims ordinance seconded by Jenkins and Carried.

Brinker moved that there be apportioned from the unapportioned fund to the Street fund \$150⁶⁵ and to the police and Salary fund \$250⁰⁰ seconded by Love and Carried.

Claims Ordinance

An Ordinance being prepared providing for the payment of the bills read and approved was read and Love moved the same be placed on its passage seconded by Brinker Devine moved to amend by striking out the bill of Brinker Hull & Crubbaugh. seconded by Early

The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas

declared lost.

The yeas and nays were then called on the
passage of the ordinance resulting yeas Brinker

Wilson. Yeas 7 nays 4. and the ordinance
was declared passed.

Barley moved that the fire committee
remove the horse kept for the fire Dept from
the building in which it is now kept. seconded
by Brinker. after considerable discussion and
various motions and amendments. it was
finally agreed on motion Love seconded by
Brinker that a stable be built at the south
End of the city hall and connected therewith by
an arch cut through the wall said structure
to not cost more than \$100⁰⁰ the vote on
the same being Yeas Brinker Bush Cowm
Crawbough Gable Love Wilson

Mayr Bush Divine Carley Jenkins Yeas 7 nays 4
 Divine moved that the building be
 constructed of brick at a cost not to exceed
 \$200⁰⁰ seconded by Bush and lost yeas Bush
 Crown Divine Carley Gabele Jenkins. Yeas
 Brinker Buck Crubamph Love Wilson.
 yeas 6 nays 5

Brinker moved that the sidewalk
 committee be instructed to tear up all dangerous
 sidewalks on Linden avenue seconded by Bush and

 Gabele Jenkins Love Wilson yeas 8 nays 0

Gabele offered the following and moved
 its adoption. "Be it resolved that it is the sense
 of this council that the east main street bridge
 committee report at the next regular meeting
 of this council" seconded by Brinker and carried
 yeas 8 nays 0.

On motion of Bush seconded by Buck
 the clerk was instructed to notify Wm Shidder to
 so arrange as to run the sewerage and waste water from
 his barn on the east side of Seneca Street into the
 Seneca Street sewer.

On motion of Jenkins seconded by Brinker
 the street Commissioner was instructed to make an approach
 to the sidewalk laid by Wm Gindesmith on Linden Ave. at the
 Alley at the north end of said sidewalk

Attention was called to the condition of the
 sidewalk on Wayne Street north of the School building
 and on motion of Bush the same was referred to the
 sidewalk committee with power to raise the same
 where it was too low.

It being reported that the Street R.R.Co contemplated an
 extension of their tracks thereby necessitating the tearing up
 of certain paved streets. Brinker moved the same be referred to
 a special committee and the Solicitor seconded by Bush
 and Carried. President Wilson appointed Brinker Jenkins Love
 and Bush. Matter of depression in sidewalk on
 Broadway at first alley west of Arch was on motion of
 Buck referred to sidewalk committee with
 Power to act. Council then adjourned
