

Council Chamber Alliance O January 2nd 1893

Council met in regular session with President Wilson in the chair and the following members present. Brinker Buck Bush Cornbough Gabel and Love. Absent Leonard Devine Earley Jenkins and Kayler. Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

Mayor's report

The Mayor's report for the month of December 1892 was read showing fines and licenses to the amount of \$484⁰⁰ collected and turned over to the city clerk and on motion of Gabel seconded by Brinker the same was accepted and ordered placed on file.

company

A Communication from the Alliance Water Works Co. Stating that they had completed their contract and that all extensions had been made and hydrants erected as provided for in said contract. also that the new Standpipe had been completed and that the system as completed would give the amount of pressure provided for in the contract viz 30 lbs per sq inch.

Brinker moved that the communication be referred to the water committee with instructions to investigate the workings of the system and have the same thoroughly tested as to pressure and to report in writing at next meeting seconded by Bush and carried yeas 7 nays 0.

Love moved the report be adopted seconded by Buck. and lost Yeas 7 nays 0.

A bill of M Carley for \$2⁰⁰ for services in the Laughlin case for looking over the ground with J. B. Wifty and looking up witnesses was presented and Brinker moved the same be allowed seconded by Bush. The Solicitor was then asked to give an opinion as to the legality of the same and he reported that the same could not be legally allowed.

Passage of Claims Ordinance

A number of bills against the city having been approved by the proper committees were read and Brinker moved that they be allowed and that an ordinance be prepared providing for their payment seconded by Gabelle and carried:

Council Chamber Alliance Ohio Jan 5th 1893

Council met in adjourned session with President Wilson presiding and the following members present. Brinker Buck Bush Crubough Gabele Jambius Kayler Love. Absent Cowan Divine Carley. The following communication from the cemetery trustees was read:

To the Council of the city of Alliance Ohio Gentlemen. "we are under the necessity of reporting to you that a former clerk of the board of Cemetery Directors and now a member of that board collected a large sum of money while acting as said clerk from the sale of lots &c which money belongs to the City and has refused and neglected to pay the same over to his successor or to the treasurer of said board. and we recommend that an investigation of the matter be made and such action be taken as the facts may justify." Signed W.S. Pettit. Mayor.

On motion of Brinker the same was referred to the Cemetery Committee and Solicitor to investigate.

Estimate on
Cely Street and

An Estimate on the Contract for the improvement of Cely Street for the sum of \$1575⁰⁰ in favor of John Hadley the Contractor on said improvement was presented to Council and approved for \$1122⁷⁶ by the finance Committee.

Brinker Chairman of said finance Committee stating that claims in favor of parties furnishing Labor on said street to the amount of \$452³⁰ against Mr Hazen a sub contractor under Mr Hadley had been filed with the Clerk and that in accordance with the advice of the Solicitor they had approved the estimate less the amount of said claims and asked that said amount remain in the treasury until such time as Council was satisfied as to whom said claims should be paid.

Brinker then moved that the estimate be allowed for \$1122⁷⁶ and that an ordinance be prepared providing for the payment of the same. seconded by Kayler and carried.

Brinker moved that there be appropriated
