

Alliance Ohio January 23. 1893

Special Session

Council met in Special session upon call issued by Messrs Brinker Louz and Bush for the purpose as stated in the call of Considering bids for street Lighting, hearing report of cemetery committee and to consider the sewerage question. President Wilson in the chair and all members present except Crubaugh

To advertise for bids for Lights

The Clerk reported having received no bids for street Lighting and Brinker moved that Council advertise for propositions Lighting to be received until Feb 6th 1893 and requiring bidders to bid for furnishing 6^{or more} arc lights every night all night 54 or more arc Lights from dark until midnight every night. also same number 20 nights per month. also to specify candle power of Lamps bid upon. seconded by Kayler and Carried Yeas 11 nays 0.

Cemetery Committee

The Cemetery committee asked for further ^{to report} time, which was granted, and Brinker moved that Council instruct the cemetery committee and cemetery Directors to employ an expert to audit the books of the cemetery trustees, and to look up all matters pertaining to the cemetery. seconded by Devine and carried.

Sewerage

Bush moved that the question of issuing bonds for the purpose of constructing a system of sewerage in accordance with a special act of the legislature authorizing the same be submitted to the voters of the city at the next municipal Election seconded by Kayler. Louz moved to amend by striking out the words Municipal Election and substituting, a special Election to be held the second tuesday in March. seconded by Kayler

Brinker moved to lay the motion on the table seconded by Early and Carried Brinker then moved that the matter be referred to the old sewer committee consisting of Louz Bush and Devine and the sewerage Commission to report at next meeting. seconded by Bush and Carried, adjourned
