Council met in regular session.

Vice President Bush in the chair and the following members present. Brinker Buck Crumbump Duane Ealey Goble Jenkins Kayser Love. Spent. Wilson Cowan. minutes of preceding meetings read and after being corrected with reference to the report of the committee on the bids for street lighting the same were approved.

Petition for Change of Grade on Park

A petition of residents of the fifth ward in the vicinity of Park Street and Broadway asking for change of grade on said streets was referred to the grade committee.

application of Hawkins for fire Dept

The application of Ross B. Hawkins for the position of Chief of fire Dept in place of F. M. Stanley resigned was received and referred to the fire committee

Solicitor to report manner of Special Election

On motion of Brinker seconded by Goble the solicitor was instructed to look up the law and report to council whether it will be legal to hold the coming election to vote on the question of issuing sewer bonds in the City Hall and have the votes all cast there, instead of holding in wards as contemplated.

Sever Committee Granted further time to report

The Sever committee having in charge the proposed sewer system asked for further time to report plans &c which was granted and Love moved that when Council adjourn it be to meet Thursday evening Feb 23. at which time they would be ready to report. seconded by Brinker and carried

On motion of Devine seconded by Gobelet the report was accepted and ordered placed on file.
