

Council Chamber Alliance Ohio March 6th 1843
 Council met in regular session with President
 Wilson presiding and the following members
 present Brinker Buck Bush Cowan Cumbough
 Divine Gabele Jenkins Kayler Love
 Absent Bailey. Minutes of preceding meeting
 read and approved. The Mayor's report of
 fines and Licenses collected during the month of
 February showing \$68⁰⁰ as such collection was
 read and on Motion of Brinker the same was
 was accepted and ordered filed.

Charges against
 the Marshal

A Charge of Malfeasance in office against
 Geo McFarland City Marshal preferred by M.E. Kall
 was read and on Motion of Gabele seconded by
 Jenkins the same was referred to the Police
 Committee to report at next meeting.

Report of
 Finance Committee
 and passage
 of bills

The Finance committee reported a number
 of bills approved and reported bill of F.W.
 Stanley for the Horse now used by the
 fire Dept. and Brinker moved that the
 City purchase the Horse for \$135⁰⁰ - seconded
 by Love. The yeas and nays were called
 resulting yeas Brinker Buck Bush Cowan
 Cumbough Divine Gabele Jenkins Kayler
 Love Wilson Yeas 11 nays 0. and the
 motion was declared Carried.

The bills approved were read and
 Brinker moved that an Ordinance be prepared
 providing for their payment. seconded by
 Kayler and Carried.

On Motion of Brinker seconded by Bush
 there was apportioned from the unapportioned
 fund to the Street fund \$625⁰⁰.

The Ordinance for the payment of the
 bills being prepared was read and Bush
 moved the same be placed on its passage
 seconded by Brinker and Carried Yeas
 Brinker Buck Bush Cowan Cumbough
 Divine Gabele Jenkins Kayler
 Love Wilson Yeas 11 nays 0

Bush reported that the water crossing Liberty Street South of Summit was doing damage to sidewalks on Summit Street and offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

Be it resolved that it is the sense of This Council that the Street Committee be authorized to Construct or have Constructed a culvert crossing Summit Street between South Webb and Morgan avenues provided that the cost of construction of such Culvert shall not exceed Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) and the same to be paid out of the general fund. Kayler seconded the motion to adopt. The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Brinker Buck Bush Brown Lambrough Devine Gabel Jenkins Kayler Love Wilson. Yeas 11 nays 0. and the resolution was declared adopted.

Attention was called to the fact of water damaging property of D. Beck on Keystone Street and on motion of Devine the same was referred to the Street Committee.

Devine reported that Mr D. Pato desired permission to erect pair of scales on Warehouse Street in front of his warehouse and on motion of Love seconded by Buck the same was referred to the Street Committee with power to grant the request.

Gabel reported that F W Gaskill requested the privilege of using a portion of the street for material in the construction of his building on Main Street near the old Opera house, and on motion of Kayler the same was granted allowing him the use of that portion of the street and sidewalk allowed by law.

Mr Murray Webb being present made a similar request to the above and on motion of Bush the same was granted subject to the orders of the Street Committee.

On Motion of Jenkins seconded by Buck. Yeas 11 nays 0 the Grade Committee and engineers were instructed to prepare a grade ordinance for South Webb Avenue.
