

Council Chamber Alliance Ohio March 9" 1893

Special  
Session on  
Sewer question

Council met in special session upon the following Call. Do - You are hereby notified that a special meeting of the Alliance City Council is called to meet Thursday evening March 9" 1893 at 7 o'clock P.M. for the consideration of the Sewerage question. The president and vice president both being absent on motion of Brinker. Kayler was elected Chairman pro tem. and the following members answered the Roll call. Brinker Buck Covan Cumbugh. Dowie Gabel and Love. Bush arriving during the session. Absent Carley Jenkins Wilson.

The following resolution was read:

Be it resolved by the Council of the city of Alliance Ohio that the public health convenience and welfare of all <sup>the</sup> citizens within the corporate limits and of part of the territory adjoining said corporation requires the improvement of a certain stream or water course known as Trails run by the location, alteration, and construction of a ditch or drain by straightening widening deepening and tiling or otherwise constructing a covered ditch together with the necessary laterals and branches along or near the following route:

Beginning at or near the intersection of Broadway and Meadow Avenue in the city of Alliance thence in a northerly and Easterly direction to the Culvert under the P. D. W. & C. R. R. thence in a northerly direction along or near Maple Avenue to Patterson Street thence in a northerly and westerly by the best and most practical route to an outlet in the Mahoning river below and near the Water Works Co's dam. The Mayor of the City of Alliance is hereby authorized to present to the Commissioners of Stark County a petition signed by him officially with a bond in the sum of one hundred dollars for the location and construction of a ditch as above described

Brinker moved the above resolution be adopted seconded by Love. The yeas and nays were called resulting

The Petition provided for in the  
 foregoing resolution was read as follows:

To The Honorable board of  
 Commissioners of Stark County Ohio  
 Gentlemen The undersigned petitioners would  
 respectfully represent that the public health convenience  
 and welfare of all the citizens of the city of  
 Alliance Ohio and of a part of the territory  
 adjacent to said city requires the improvement of  
 a certain stream or water course known as Fruit's  
 run by the location, alteration and construction of  
 of a ditch or drain by straightening, widening  
 deepening and tiling or otherwise constructing a  
 covered ditch together with the necessary laterals or  
 branches along or near the following route:

Beginning at or near the intersection of Broadway  
 and Maple Avenue in the city of Alliance thence in  
 a northerly and easterly direction to the culvert  
 under the P. H. W. & C. R. R. thence in northerly direction  
 along or near Maple Avenue to Patterson Street  
 thence in a northerly and westerly direction by the  
~~most~~ best and most practical route to an outlet  
 in the Mahoning river below and near the Water  
 Works Co's dam. Your Petitioners would therefor  
 pray that such action be taken as will bring about  
 this improvement as soon as possible in accordance  
 with law.

A bond in the sum of \$100<sup>00</sup> to accompany the  
 above petition was also read and on motion of Bush  
 seconded by Drvine the finance Committee was  
 instructed to sign the bond on the part of the  
 City as surety.

Love Moved that a special Committee be appointed  
 to accompany the Mayor to Canton to file the  
 petition. Seconded by Brinker and carried.

The President appointed as said Committee  
 Brinker & Bush Council then adjourned.
