The fire Committee reported having visited Salem and inspected the fire system and reported as being well pleased with the same. and on Motion of Brinker the said Committee was instructed to make report in writing on the same at next meeting.

Resolution  
for special  
election

The following resolution was read  
Resolved by the Council of the City of Alliance Ohio that at the regular Election to be held on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of April AD 1893 there be submitted to the qualified Electors of said City the proposition whether or not the Council shall have power to issue the bonds of said City in any sum not exceeding \$1,250,000.00 for the purpose of making permanent Street improvements as authorized by House bill no 1770 passed by the general Assembly of the State of Ohio April 23<sup>rd</sup> 1891. That the tickets to be used at said Election shall have written or printed thereon the words. Issue of Bonds for Street Improvements Yes

That the Clerk is hereby directed to have published a notice of said Election as provided by Law and he is also ~~notified~~ directed to notify the County board of elections to place the above

proposition on the regular tickets. That it is hereby declared the intention of the council is that the proceeds of the sale of said bonds if the authority to issue the same is granted shall be used for the following purposes to wit: first - to pay for improving Liberty Street from Main Street to Patterson Street by making approaches to an overhead bridge to be erected over the Pittsburgh, Fort Wayne and Chicago Railway Company's right of way and for the appropriating the necessary lots or lands. That the amount to be used for this purpose shall not exceed \$8000<sup>00</sup>.

Second - To pay for improving the Highway known as Lincoln Avenue from Main Street north to Ely Street by making the necessary approaches to an overhead bridge to be erected across the Pittsburgh Ft Wayne and Chicago Co's right of way. That the amount to be used for this purpose shall not exceed \$3000<sup>00</sup>. Third - to pay for making a fill on east Oxford Street between Park Avenue and Mechanic Avenue and grading the streets adjacent thereto where the same is necessary. That the amount for this purpose shall not exceed \$1500<sup>00</sup>.

That no more shall be used for each of the improvements therein specified and if in any case the Maximum is not needed the balance shall be applied to the payment of the principal and interest of the bonds that may be issued."

Bush moved the adoption of the resolution seconded by Devine. The yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Bruiker, Buck, Bush, Crutbaugh, Devine, Gabel, Jenkins, Kayler, Wilson, Yeas 9 nays 0 and the resolution was declared adopted.

Brinter offered the following resolution and moved its adoption.

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Alliance Ohio that the buildings and grounds committee be instructed to have built a room on the north side of the Sixth ward city building for the purpose of keeping property of the fire department the expense not to exceed \$150<sup>00</sup> to be paid out of the general fund of the city". Gabel seconded the motion to adopt. The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Bunker Buck Bush Combs & Devine Gabel Jenkins Kayler. Wilson. Yeas 9 nays 0.

Street R.R. Co  
for franchise

Mr W. W. Hazard of the Street Rail Way Company being present submitted the following: "To the Common Council of the City of Alliance Ohio Gentlemen. The undersigned respectfully makes application for the extension of its Street Railway route in the City of Alliance over and upon the following ~~route~~ streets: Commencing at the corner of Main Street and Union Avenue thence north on Union Avenue to Vine Street thence west on Vine Street to the Corporation line. Also commencing at the corner of North Union Avenue and Ely Street thence west on west Ely Street to North Lincoln Avenue thence north on North Lincoln Avenue to west Vine Street with single track with needed switches and turnouts subject to all the terms and conditions of the ordinance granting said Street Railway Company the use of streets now occupied by the same so far as the same is

applicable except that no paving or macadamizing shall be required of the said Street Railway Co. on the Streets above named". Respectfully submitted
