filing of Claims
 for damages

The Clerk reported that Claims for damages
 to property on account of changing grades on
 Streets by Mrs Weirich for \$800⁰⁰ and Daniel, C
 Hazen for \$11111⁰⁰ had been filed and the
 same were referred to the Judiciary Committee.

The Street Committee to whom had
 been referred the matter of the ^{proposed} franchise for the
 extension of the Street R.R. asked for further time
 and gave as a reason for the request they desired
 that the company give a satisfactory guarantee
 that they would comply with the requirements
 and conditions of a franchise before granting
 same.

 Proposition
 of Chapin

Lovv moved that the proposition of
 Mr L. E. Chapin for preparing plans and
 superintending the construction of the proposed
 Sewer system be taken from the table.
 (a motion to adopt the same having been
 tabled at the preceding meeting)
 seconded by Bush and carried. The
 proposition was then read and Devine
 moved that the same be accepted on
 condition that the clause relating to the
 time the superintending of construction
 shall commence and cease, seconded by
 Gabele. The yeas and nays were called
 resulting. Yeas Buck Devine Gabele,
 nays Bush Crumbayh Jenkins Lovv

Wilson. Yeas 3 nays 5. The motion was
 declared lost and the yeas and nays
 called on the original motion to a accept
 resulting. Yeas Buck Bush Jenkins
 Lovv Wilson Nays Crumbayh Devine
 Gabele. Before the result was announced
 Bush asked to change his vote and have
 it recorded nay, and the result was

Passage of
Fire Alarm
Ordinance

announced yeas 4 nays 4 and the motion was declared lost. An Ordinance entitled 'An Ordinance Establishing a fire Alarm and Police Telegraph System for the City of Alliance Ohio and Contracting with William S. August for the Maintenance and operation of the same. was called for and having been read the third time Love moved the same be placed on its passage seconded by Bush and carried yeas Buck Bush Corubaugh Gabel Jenkins Love Wilson. Yeas 7 nays 0. and the Ordinance was declared passed.

fire Com
to build
stable

Love moved that the matter of building a stable and making the necessary changes in the building for the accommodation of the fire system just adopted be referred to the fire committee with power to act. the cost not to exceed \$500⁰⁰ seconded by Buck and carried yeas 7 nays 0.

locate fire
alarm boxes

Gabel moved that there be a committee of six consisting of one Councilman from each ward be appointed to locate the fire alarm boxes seconded by Bush and carried.

President Wilson appointed as said committee Cowan, Gabel, Bush, Kayler, Buck and Corubaugh.

resolution
to accept
Chapin's
Proposition

Bush moved that the vote on the acceptance of L. E. Chapin's proposition be reconsidered seconded by Buck and carried yeas 7 nays 0.

Bush then offered the following resolution as an amendment to the motion.

Be it resolved that it is the sense of this Council that L. E. Chapin's proposition to do certain work in making plans &c for a system of sewerage be approved provided that Mr Chapin, so amend his proposition to specify the length of time the Superintendent be employed.

and moved its adoption seconded by Jenkins. The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Buck Bush Corubaugh Gabel Jenkins Love Wilson yeas 7 nays 0.
