

Council Chamber Alliance Ohio May 1st 1893

Council met in regular session with president Wilson in the chair and members all present. Minutes of preceding meetings read and approved. The Mayor's report for the month of April of fines and licenses collected to the amount of \$106 ⁸⁰ was read and on motion of Divine accepted and ordered placed on file.

A Petition asking for the extension of the water main on Rosenberg Street was referred to the Water Committee.

Petition for sidewalk
line on Ely
Street

A Petition from property owners on Ely Street asking Council to establish the sidewalk line on said Street two feet from the property line was read.

~~On motion of Buck permission was granted property owners on Grant Street between Arch and Union Avenues to grade said Grant Street under the supervision of the Street Committee ^{and engineer}, on condition that such grading should be done without expense to the City and the parties doing such grading to have all dirt not needed on the street to bring the same to grade.~~

On Motion of Buck seconded by Looe the Matter of Grading Grant Street between Arch Street and Union Avenue was referred to the Street Committee and engineer with power to grant property owners the privilege of putting the same to grade they to have the surplus dirt not needed on the Street. The Judiciary Committee to whom had been referred the matter of ascertaining the liability of the Street R R Co for their portion of payment for paving done on streets reported as follows:

"In the matter of the liability of the Street R. R. Co to pay a portion of the expense of the brick pavement on east main Street from Union Ave to Mechanic Ave over which said Railway Company are about to lay their tracks we beg leave to report that in the opinion of this committee the Street Railway Company cannot under their franchise with the city be compelled to pay any portion of this pavement or of other pavements completed before their tracks are laid"

The Police Committee submitted the following: We the undersigned by leave to submit the following report: We recommend the employment for the ensuing year of two policemen in addition to the fire patrol at a salary of fifty Dollars per month. We recommend that in the selection of the police force of the City that care be taken to select such persons as are known to be efficient, to favor the enforcement of law and order and willing to perform their full duties as provided by law. On Motion of Bush seconded by Conger the matter of Establishing a grade on West Grant Street was referred to the platting and grade committee to report at next meeting.

Passage of Ordinance at Liberty

An Ordinance to establish a grade on North Liberty Street was read first time and on motion of Gabele seconded by Devine Yeas 12 nays 0 The rules were suspended and the ordinance read second time by title and on motion of Devine seconded by ~~Devine~~ Bush the rules were again suspended and the ordinance read third time and Devine moved the same be placed on its final passage seconded by Gabele the yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Buck Bush Conger Cowan Crumbaugh Davidson Devine Gabele Harris Love Williams Wilson Yeas 12 nays 0 and the ordinance was declared passed.

Passage of a grade ordinance on Simpson st

(Bush voting nay) The rules were again suspended and the ordinance read third time and Devine moved the same be placed on its passage seconded by Gabele. The yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Buck Conger Cowan Crumbaugh Davidson Devine Gabele Harris Love Williams Wilson. Nay Bush Yeas 11 nays 0 and the ordinance was declared passed.

On motion of Bush it was agreed that when Council adjourns it be to meet on Monday evening May the 8th
