Harris offered the following resolution and moved its adoption: "In view of the many requests made of members of this Council by business men in the city to have additional time to remove the awnings included in the resolution passed at the last meeting of Council. Resolved that the time within which to remove these awnings be extended to Sept 15. 1893 with the understanding however that this extension shall not apply to such awnings as are in the opinion of the street committee dangerous to the public or property. Resolved that it shall be the duty of the Street Committee to make an inspection of these wooden awnings and to report at the next meeting of Council all awnings that are in a dangerous condition."

Sept ~~was~~ seconded the motion to adopt. The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Buck Conger Davidson Harris Love Sefert Wilson. Nays Bush Cornbough Gabele Williams. Yeas 7 nays 4 and the resolution was declared adopted.
