Council met in regular session with President Wilson in the Chair and the following members present, Buck Bush, Lewan Conger, Corbough, Davidson, Gable, Low, Sept, Williams. Absent Harris. The Clerk being absent Davidson was chosen Clerk pro tem.

Mayor's report
for July

The Mayor's report for the month of July reporting fines and licenses collected during the month amounting to \$318.⁰⁰ \$6.⁰⁰ of which was turned over to the County Treasurer and \$312.⁰⁰ to the City Clerk.

Finance Com

Low of the finance Committee reported that the committee had approved a number of bills but owing to the absence of the Clerk no ordinance providing for their payment had been prepared and moved that when Council adjourn it be to meet in one week. Carried

Bad Bridge on
Noble Street

Davidson reported a bridge at the east end of Noble Street in bad condition also some repairs needed on Rush Street near the River Cocks and the same was referred to the Street Committee.

Pave Gutter
at Wright & Pennocks

On Motion of Bush it was ordered that sufficient Brick and cement be furnished to pave the gutter at the South west corner of Wright and Pennocks Store.

Grade Crossing
on Broadway

On motion of Bush the Street Committee was instructed to have the Alley Crossing on the north side of Broadway and between Liberty and Webb avenues put to grade at a cost not to exceed \$5.⁰⁰

Betts Sidewalk

Davidson reported bad condition of the sidewalk in front of the A. A. Betts property on North Union Avenue and it was ordered that the owner be notified to repair the same.

Buck reported that the sidewalk in front of Arthur Rice's property on

South Arch Street, needed repairing and the same was referred to the sidewalk committee

A resolution ordering the owner of Lot no 2134 (James Butler) to construct a sidewalk in front of said lot was read and Bush moved the adoption of the same seconded by Gabel and Carried yeas 11 nays 0

A resolution requiring the owner of Lot no 2135 (Mary Cook) to construct a sidewalk in front of said lot was read and on motion of Buck seconded by Bush the same was adopted yeas 11 nays none

Sewer
Ordinance

An Ordinance to improve the City of Alliance by constructing a West side main sewer was read 1st time and Love moved the rules be suspended and the ordinance be read second time by title seconded by Buck. The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Buck Bush Conger Conner Crumbaugh Davidson Gabel Love Siefert Williams Wilson yeas 11 nays 0 The rules were declared suspended, the ordinance was read second time by title and Love moved the rules be again suspended and the ordinance be read 3rd time seconded by Buck. The yeas and nays were called resulting same as before yeas 11 nays none. The ordinance was read third time and Love moved the same be placed on its passage seconded by Bush. The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Bush Bush Conger Conner Crumbaugh Davidson Gabel Love Siefert Williams Wilson yeas 11 nays none and the ordinance was declared passed

An Ordinance to improve the City of Alliance by constructing an East side main sewer was read first time and on motion of Love seconded by Buck yeas 11 nays none the rules were declared suspended and the ordinance read second time by title and on motion of Love seconded by Buck yeas 11 nays none the rules were again suspended and the ordinance read third time and Love moved the same be placed on its passage seconded by Bush. The yeas and nays were called resulting

declared passed

Bush offered the following

resolved that it is the sense of this Council
that Mr Chapin be employed to have a
tracing of the new city map made at the
lowest possible expense and that the said
tracing include all additions legally recorded
since the last map was made.

Williams seconded the motion to adopt
the yeas and nays were called resulting
Yeas. Bush Crubauagh Gabell Defert
Williams Wilson. Nays Buck Conger
Cowan Davidson Love. Yeas 6 nays 5 and
the motion to adopt was declared lost

Bush offered the following
resolution and moved its adoption.

Be it resolved that it is the sense of
this Council that one half of all fines
collected by the Mayor be placed to the credit
of the police and fire fund. seconded by
Williams. The yeas and nays were
called resulting Yeas Bush Conger Crubauagh
Davidson Defert Williams Wilson. Nays
Love Cowan Gabell Love. Yeas 7 nays
4 and the resolution was declared adopted

Love offered the following
resolution and moved its adoption

Be it resolved that the City Clerk be and
he is hereby instructed to advertise for bids
for the construction of east and west side
main sewers in accordance with plans
and specifications now on file as provided
by law. Buck seconded the motion

to adopt. The yeas and nays were called
resulting. Yeas Buck Bush Conger Cowan
Crubauagh Davidson Gabell Love
Defert Williams Wilson. Yeas 11 nays none
and the resolution was declared adopted
