E. Chapin relative to making a tracing of the city map and the placing the numbers of the lots in new additions thereon referred to the same committee

Payment  
of bills

A number of bills against the city having been approved by the proper Committees were read and on motion of Lov seconded by Davidson the same were allowed as read and an ordinance ordered prepared providing for their payment. There not being sufficient money in certain funds to pay the appropriations called for in the bills as read on motion of Lov seconded by Gabel there was apportioned from any unapportioned money in the treasury to the General fund \$245<sup>00</sup> and to the Street fund \$275<sup>00</sup>. The Ordinance for the payment of the bills was then read and Lov moved the same be placed on its passage seconded by Buck. The Yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Bush Bush Cowan Davidson Gabel Lov Defert Williams, Wilson. Yeas 9 nays none and the ordinance was declared passed.
