

Council Chamber Alliance Ohio Sept 11th 1843

Council met in adjourned session
The president and Vice president being absent.
On motion of Bush seconded by Davidson. Harris was
Chosen president pro tem. The roll was called and
the following members present. Bush Conger
Crombaugh Davidson Love. absent Corvan Defert
Williams Wilson. Gabele came in and took his
seat shortly after Council convened.

Notice of injunction
on Clippinger bill

Notice of an injunction in the Common Pleas
Court restraining the city from paying the bill of J.L.
Clippinger for \$99⁰⁰ was presented.

Passage of
Claims Ordinance

Gabele moved that the vote on the
motion of the preceding meeting to allow the

be reconsidered seconded by Conger and carried.

Love then moved that the bills as read at the
meeting of Sept 4th except the bill of J.L. Clippinger
for \$99⁰⁰ for extra Police services be allowed and

Milner Street
