

Council Chamber Alliance Ohio Sept 18 1843

Council met in regular session with President Wilson presiding and the following members present. Buck Conyer Cowan Davidson Gabel Lovv Harris Sefert Williams. Absent. Bush Combaugh and Harris. Minutes of Meetings of Sept 4th and 11th read and approved.

1st reading of
Sewer ordinance

An Ordinance to provide for the construction of a storm water Sewer was read first time.

To improve
City lot

Lovv offered the following resolution and moved its adoption. "Whereas certain citizens have made a proposition to improve the city lot by planting trees and shrubbery and otherwise beautifying the same. Therefore be it resolved that permission be granted to ~~some~~ improve said lot under the direction of a committee consisting of three members of Council ~~and three~~ to be appointed by the president of the Council and three citizens hereafter to be appointed" Davidson seconded the motion to adopt. The yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Buck Conyer Cowan Davidson Gabel Lovv Sefert Williams Wilson. Yeas 9 nays none and the resolution was declared adopted.

Sewer ordinance

Lovv moved that the rules be suspended and the ordinance to provide for the construction of a storm water Sewer be read second time by title seconded by Buck. The yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Buck Conyer Cowan Davidson Gabel Lovv ~~Harris~~ Sefert Williams Wilson. Yeas 9 nays none

The rules were declared suspended the ordinance was read second time by title and Gabel moved that the rules be again suspended and the ordinance be read third time. seconded by Sefert. The yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Buck Conyer Cowan Davidson Gabel ~~Harris~~ Lovv Sefert Williams Wilson. Yeas 9 nays none. The rules were declared suspended. The ordinance was read third time and Lovv moved the passage of the same seconded by Conyer. The yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Buck Conyer Cowan Davidson Gabel Lovv Sefert Williams Wilson. Yeas 9 nays 0 and the ordinance was declared passed

Love moved that the Clerk be instructed to advertise for bids for the labor necessary to construct ~~the~~ the sewer provided for in the foregoing ordinance also for the sewer pipe for same seconded by Gabelle the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Buck Conger Cowan Davidson Gabelle Love Defert Williams Wilson yeas 9 nays none and the motion was declared carried

Washington Street
Grade Ordinance

An Ordinance to establish a grade on Washington Street was read the second time and Davidson moved the rules be suspended and the ordinance be read third time seconded by Conger the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Buck Conger Cowan Davidson Gabelle Love Defert Williams Wilson yeas 9 nays none the rules were declared suspended the ordinance was read third time and Davidson moved the final passage of the same seconded by Conger the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Buck Conger Cowan Davidson Gabelle Love Defert Williams Wilson yeas 9 nays none and the ordinance was declared passed

Passage of
Jersey Street
Grade Ordinance

An Ordinance to establish a grade on Jersey Street was read third time and Davidson moved the same be placed on its final passage seconded by Gabelle the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Buck ^{Conger} Cowan Davidson Gabelle Love Defert Williams Wilson yeas 9 nays none and the ordinance was declared passed

H.E. Judd to
Grade Colley's
Street

Buck reported the necessity of having Colley's Street graded west of Arch Street and stated that Mr Judd would put the same to grade for the dirt without expense to the city other than the expense of setting the grade stakes and moved that Mr Judd be given permission to do said work under direction of the Street Committee. seconded by Davidson and carried yeas Buck Conger Cowan Davidson Gabelle Love Defert Williams Wilson yeas 9 nays none

Repair South
Freedom Street

Loov called attention to a bad place in South Freedom Street at the so-called Fund Sewer and the Street committee was instructed to have the same repaired.

walk

The Sidewalk Committee to whom had been referred the Hartzell Sidewalk on North Union Avenue made the following report:

In the sidewalk Committee to whom was referred the F. E. Hartzell Sidewalks on North Union Avenue by leave to report that notice was given Mr Hartzell on August 6th 1892 to construct such sidewalk and we recommend that the necessary action be taken to have the same complied with at once.

Gabel moved the adoption of the report seconded by Davidson and Carried Yes Buck Cowan George Davidson Gabel Loov Siefert William Wilson. Yes 9 nays none

Davidson reported a bad sidewalk at the corner of Keystone and Walnut Street and the same was referred to the Sidewalk Committee

E. H. Brosius
to pay for
Hydrant

Gabel called attention of Council to the fact of the water main having been extended on West Ely Street and a Hydrant ordered located on said extension on Oct 31st 1892 and that Mr E. H. Brosius had guaranteed the payment for said Hydrant for one year and reported that the conditions had not been complied with and Davidson moved that the Clerk be instructed to collect the amount of one year's rent for one Hydrant from Mr Brosius seconded by Gabel and Carried.
