Bids for the grading of Grant Street west of Arch having been advertised for and received were read and referred to the street committee and Engineer.

Mayor's
 report

The Mayor's report for the month of Sept showing fines and licenses collected during the month amounting to \$240⁰⁰⁵⁰ was presented and on motion of Sefert seconded by Davidson the same was accepted and ordered placed on file

 R.R. Bridge

Love offered the following resolution and moved its adoption. "Whereas the City and Penna R.R. company have practically agreed upon terms by which over-head crossings across the R.R. tracks at the foot of Main Street and at Lincoln avenue are to be built therefore be it resolved that the method of providing the necessary funds for the same be referred to the Judiciary Committee and engineer." Sefert ^{seconded} ~~seconded~~ the adoption of the resolution. The yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas 8 nays none and the resolution was declared adopted.

Reading
 of bills
 and paying
 same

A number of bills against the city having been approved by the Finance committee were read and Love moved the same be allowed as read and that an Ordinance be prepared providing for their payment. seconded by Gabele and carried. The Ordinance being prepared and there not being sufficient ~~money~~ in certain funds to pay the appropriations contained therein. Love moved that there be apportioned from any unapportioned money in the treasury to the general fund \$175⁰⁰ and to the street fund \$60⁰⁰ seconded by Gabele and carried. The Ordinance was then read and Love moved the passage of the same seconded by Harris. The yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas

 Union Ave
 Sewer

The street committee reported a plan for taking care of the water on Union Avenue at the R R bridge as prepared by the engineer and an estimate of the cost of the same. The estimate being \$200⁰⁰. Davidson moved the adoption of the same seconded by Williams. Low moved the same be laid on the table until next meeting seconded by Davidson and Carried.

 Harrison St

The engineer reported that the proposed grading of Harrison Street and Hester Avenue which had been referred to the street committee and engineer at the preceding meeting would require the removal of about 250 cubic yards of earth and that the cost would be about \$3752. On motion of Davidson the report was adopted and on motion of Harris the Clerk was instructed to advertize for bids for doing said work.

 Solicitor

A communication having been received at a former meeting from Mr E Fawcett relative to the Railroad Company having raised their tracks near his works thereby raising the grade of the street at that point. Davidson moved that the matter be referred to the solicitor seconded by Low and Carried.

Engineer set

 Wash & Jersey St

On motion of Gabele the engineer was instructed to set grade stakes for sidewalks on Washington Street. also set grade stakes on Jersey Street.

Passage of

 Grade Ord.

An Ordinance to establish a grade on Vincent Street was read second time and on motion of Gabele seconded by Defert, ^{Yeas & nays none} the rules were suspended and the ordinance read third time. And Gabele moved the ordinance be placed on its final passage seconded by Crumbaugh. The yeas and nays

were called resulting Yeas Cowan Crubough Davidson Gabele Harris Love Sefert Williams Wilson Yeas 9 nays none and the ordinance was declared passed.

Report on heating fire Dept

The fire committee to whom had been referred the matter of heating the rooms occupied by the fire department submitted plans and specifications for heating the fire department rooms. Mayor's and Clerk's office with steam. and Davidson moved the same be adopted seconded by Goble the yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Cowan Davidson Gabele Love Sefert Williams Wilson. Nays Crubough Harris Yeas 7 nays ~~two~~ and the motion was declared carried. and Davidson moved that the clerk be instructed to advertise for bids for heating the city building in accordance with the specifications for same. seconded by Williams. The yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Cowan Davidson Gabele Harris Love ^{Sefert} Williams Wilson. Nays Crubough Yeas 8 nays 1. and the motion was declared carried.

committee on Weirich Carl

The Solicitor stated to Council that the case of Weirich vs The City would likely come up for trial during this term of Court and asked that Council appoint a committee to take charge of the same and president Wilson appointed as said committee. Crubough, Love and Harris.

ad for coal

On Motion of Love the Clerk was instructed to advertise for bids for furnishing the city with coal for the ensuing year.

city lot com

President Wilson appointed W.S. Arnyat as a member of the committee having in charge the improvement of the city lot.
