Bids for the grading of Grant Street having been referred to the Street Committee reported that the bid of S. S. Grimes was the lowest the same being \$83⁰⁰ and Davidson moved the same be accepted seconded by Corvan the yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Conyer Corvan Davidson Williams Wilson nays Lovv and Harris Yeas 5 nays 2 and the motion was declared lost.

Bids having been received for heating the City Hall with Steam the same were submitted as follows:

Lovv moved that the contract for heating the City building be awarded to F. L. Vessariat at the above bid seconded by Defert. Davidson

moved to lay the same on the table until next meeting seconded by Harris and carried. and on motion of Love Harris and Conger were added to the Committee on heating the City building.

Grade

A bid of S. S. Grimes for the grading on Harrison Street and Hester Avenue as advertised for at \$30⁰⁰ was read and Davidson moved the same be accepted seconded by Cowan, and on motion of Harris seconded by Love the matter was laid on the table until next meeting.

On Motion of Harris the fire Committee was instructed to provide the necessary ^{oil stoves} ~~means~~ to heat the firemen's room until such time as Council determined upon a permanent plan for heating same. No further business Council adjourned.
