

Council Chamber Alliance Ohio Oct 24 1893

Council met in adjourned session President Wilson presiding and the following members present. Buck Bush Conger Gable Love Williams. Absent Cowan. Crubaugh Davidson Harris Defert.

The Sewer Committee to whom had been referred the bids for the Rush Street Sewer report on submitted the following report: The Sewer bids Committee to whom was referred the bids for the Rush Street Sewer beg leave to make the following report: That the bid of the Youngstown Ice Co for sewer pipe be accepted. Also that the bid of Mr W<sup>m</sup> Conrad for excavating, laying sewer pipe and back filling be accepted. Signed A. B. Love & B. Bush Committee on sewers.

Love reported that Mr Macanley would not accept the contract for the excavating and labor at his bid unless he was also awarded the contract for the sewer pipe.

Love moved the adoption of the ~~resolution~~ report of the sewer committee seconded by Conger and carried Yeas Buck Bush Conger Gable Love Williams Wilson. Yeas 7 nays none.

On motion of Love seconded by Bush the Mayor and clerk were authorized to enter into a contract with Mr Conrad for the labor for the Rush Street Sewer also with the Youngstown Ice Co for the sewer pipe for same. in accordance with their respective bids. Yeas 7 nays none.

Buck reported that the sewer on Roseberry Street needed to be extended farther west and the matter was referred to the Sewer Committee.

Roseberry St Sewer

Bush offered the following resolution and moved its adoption. "Be it resolved that it is the sense of this Council that the bid of Oby & Co for fitting up the City Hall with apparatus for heating the same with steam be and is hereby accepted provided the work be completed within fifteen days." Williams seconded the motion to adopt. ~~The year and nays were~~

resolution to accept bid of Oby & Co

On motion of Bush seconded by Buck the same was laid on the table.

Buck offered the following resolution and moved its adoption. "Whereas the hill on South Liberty Avenue is in very bad condition by washing and likely to become impassable. Be it resolved that the said hill be widened and improved and the Clerk be instructed to advertise for bids by the Yard to be estimated by the Engineer. The work to be paid for out of funds appropriated for that purpose." Bush ~~seconded~~ seconded the motion to adopt the yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Buck Bush Conyer Goble Love Williams Wilson Yeas 7 nays 0 and the resolution was declared adopted.

Goble called attention to the condition of the crossing on Patterson Street near the electric light works and reported the same as being too low. also reported some work that needed to be done on Front Street all of which was referred to the Street Committee.

Bush reported that the Alley running parallel with and on the north side of Main Street was in bad condition near Wards Warehouse and that if the city would be at the expense of grading the same the property owners in that vicinity would place slay thereon and make it passable and in good condition. and moved that the Clerk be instructed to notify the Street Commissioner to grade the same seconded by Williams and carried Yeas 7 nays none.

Buck reported a washout on Simpson Street between Arch and Union Avenues and the same was referred to the Street Committee to report an estimate of the cost of <sup>putting</sup> the street in passable condition.

Sewer

Bush reported that parties living east of the County line and near Patterson Street had taken the liberty to tap the Patterson street sewer and was using it to drain water closets. and moved that the street commissioners be instructed to take up the sewer at the point where it connects with the city sewer and remove the same ~~and~~ to prevent the drainage coming in. Love moved to amend by referring to the Street committee to investigate. seconded by Conger and lost. Love then moved to amend by referring to the sewer committee with power to act. Carried. The yeas and nays were then called ~~resulting~~ on the motion as amended and lost  
Yeas Buck ~~Bush~~ Conger Gabele Love. Nays Bush Williams Wilson. Yeas 4 nays 3.
