

An Ordinance to Prevent Peddling at the Depot.

Sec 1 Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Incorporated Village of Alliance, Ohio, That it shall be unlawful for any person, or persons, to peddle any articles to or at the trains upon the Rail Roads, or at, or in the vicinity of the junction of the Rail Roads in said Village, Each and every person so offending shall upon conviction thereof before the Mayor, be fined in any sum not exceeding five dollars, and be imprisoned not more than five days, or both at the discretion of the Mayor, together with costs of prosecution and stand committed until the fine and costs are paid.

Sec 2 An Ordinance passed August 16th 1865 in relation to pedlar boys be and the same is hereby repealed.

Sec 3 This Ordinance shall be in force from and after its passage and publication.

An Ordinance in Relation to Slaughter Houses.

Sec 1 Be it Ordained by the Town Council of the Incorporated Village of Alliance, That it shall be unlawful for any person, or persons to use any building or buildings, within the Incorporated limits of said Village, as a slaughter house, or house for the rendering of lard, tallow or offal, or throw anything resulting from slaughtering an animal of the Cattle kind, Sheep kind, or the kind, decayed or spoiled fish, into any stream of water, or to bury the same near to any well or cistern within said Village, or to throw the same on the ground, within the Village limits, or to permit the same to remain anywhere within the borough limits to the annoyance of any person.

Sec 2 Any person Violating any part or parts of this section first, shall upon conviction thereof, be fined in any sum not exceeding twenty dollars, or less than five dollars, and pay all expenses of abating and removing the same.

That if any person or persons shall steal and carry away from the lot or land of another any vegetable growing thereon, or garden truck or ornamental flowers on the property of an other, every person so offending upon conviction thereof be fined in any sum not less than three nor more than Fifty dollars, with costs of prosecution, and may in addition at the discretion of the Court be imprisoned not to exceed thirty days.

Sec 5 This Ordinance shall be in force from and after its passage and publication.

An Ordinance in relation to Stallions and Jacks.

Sec 1 Be it Ordained by the Town Council of the Incorporated Village of Alliance; That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to keep any stallion horse or Jack, within the limits of said Village to serve Mares, with his or their Horse or Jack, in any street, alley lot, or any other place open to public view, within the limits of said Village.

Sec 2 Every person violating the provisions of the first section of this Ordinance shall upon conviction before the Mayor, or other proper officer, be fined in the sum of Five dollars for every offence.

Sec 3 This Ordinance shall be in force from and after its passage and publication.

An ordinance to Reduce the width of 4th street in Westus, Ohio, in accordance with the requisitions of the law in such cases made and provided. Be it Ordained by the Town Council of the Incorporated Village of Alliance, Stark County, Ohio, That the Fourth street, in Westus, addition to the town of Alliance, be reduced in width to Forty feet, by the vacation of ten feet on each side of said Street.

An Amendment to the Ordinance on Nuisance
Passed May 25th 1856,

Sec. 1st Be it Ordained by the Town Council of the Incorporated Village of Alliance, Ohio, That it shall be unlawful for the owner, or occupier of any premises within said Village to allow any filth or nuisance to accumulate in or upon their said premises.

Sec 2 That every person so offending shall upon conviction thereof be fined in any sum Fifty Dollars, together with the costs of suit and the necessary expenses to remove said filth or nuisance.

Sec 3 It shall be the duty of the Mayor, immediately after the conviction of any person under the above sections, to issue his Order or warrant to the Marshal, Commanding him to remove or abate said nuisance forthwith.

Sec 4 That it shall be unlawful for any person to deposit in or upon any of the streets, alleys, or public grounds, within said Village, any filth or nuisance, Every person so offending shall upon conviction of the same, be fined in any sum not exceeding Fifty dollars, together with the costs of suit, and the necessary expenses of removing such nuisance.

Sec 5 All suits shall be brought in the name of the Incorporated Village of Alliance, Ohio, and shall be commenced by summons, as in other civil suits, and Judgement shall be rendered in the name of said Village, for the fine, costs and necessary expenses, and shall be collected by execution as in other cases.

Sec 6 All Monies Collected on the above Ordinance shall be paid into the Village Treasury as other fines.

Sec 7 This Ordinance shall be in force from and after its passage and publication.
