

Council Chamber Alliance Ohio Feb 5 1894

Council met in regular session with President Wilson presiding and the following members present. Buck Bush Conger Cowan Crumbaugh Davidson Gable. Lov. About Harris Seft and Williams. Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

The Mayor's report for the month of January of fines and licenses collected and turned over to the City Clerk to the amount of \$221²⁵ and to the County Treasurer \$26⁰⁰ was submitted and the same accepted and ordered placed on file

A communication from the Mayor recommending the purchase of more fire hose and a better equipment of the fire dept was read and on motion of Lov received and ordered placed on file

Bush reported that the bridge committee had made arrangements to go to Pittsburgh to meet with the officials of the Penna Co relative to the proposed overhead crossing and moved that an appropriation of ten dollars be made to defray the expenses seconded by Davidson and carried.

Gable offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

"Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Alliance Ohio that the Bridge Committee be instructed to confer with the officials of the Penna Co and report as early as possible plans and specifications and an estimate of the cost of the proposed bridge across the R.R. tracks at the east end of Main Street"

Davidson seconded the motion to adopt. The Yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas 8 nays none and the resolution was declared adopted.

A number of bills against the City having been approved by the proper committees were read and on motion of ~~the~~

Seconded by Buck the same were allowed as read and an Ordinance ordered prepared providing for their payment. Love presented a bill for \$214⁸ in favor of C. C. Mybrecht for services rendered by members of Co. K. National Guards in response to a call by the Mayor to guard murderer Davidson and asked that Council act on the payment of the same. The solicitor reported that the State should pay the bill legally but it would be difficult to collect it. Davidson moved that the bill be allowed and included in the Claims Ordinance. seconded by Buck and carried.

Passage of
Claims Ordinance

The Claims ordinance being prepared and there not being sufficient money in certain funds to pay the appropriations provided for on motion of Love there was appropriated from the unappropriated to the general fund \$56⁴⁵ to the Street fund \$16⁰⁰ and to the fire fund \$10⁰⁰. The ordinance was then read and Love moved the same be placed on its passage seconded by Buck. The yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Buck Bush Conger Cowan Cruborough Davidson Gabels Love Wilson Yeas 9 nays none and the Ordinance was declared passed.

Motion to repair
Crossing lost

Davidson reported that there was need of a crossing at the intersection of Mechanic and Cambridge streets and reported that certain property owners would furnish the cinders if the City would do the hauling for a crossing at that point and moved that the street commissioner be instructed to haul cinders for one day in accordance with this arrangement. seconded by Conger. The yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Buck Conger Cowan Davidson Wilson Nays Bush Cruborough Gabels Love. Yeas 6 nays 4 and the motion was declared lost.

Davidson reported that Mr Scranton desired to erect a chute or pen on Mechine Street south of Market Street to be used for loading calves into cars on the A. C. & S. R.R. and moved that permission be granted on condition that the same be subject to removal by said R.R. Company upon notice from the city. seconded by Love. The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas. Buck Bush Embaugh Davidson Love Wilson. Nays Conyer Cowan Goble yeas 6 nays 3. and President Wilson declared the motion lost.

Marshal to
notify Bureau to
remove rubbish

Bush called attention to the depositing of rubbish and ashes on the street on Linden Avenue near the intersection of Main Street by the occupants of the Keplinger House and the Marshal was instructed to notify the proprietor to remove all such rubbish from the street and not to deposit any more there.

to repair

Bush reported a bad place in the sidewalk on the south side of Ely Street just west of Park and the same was referred to the sidewalk committee to attend to.

Bush moved that the votes on the adoption of the resolution to improve the city by constructing lateral sewers no 4-10-12-12-16-17 & 27 be reconsidered (the same being adopted at the preceding meeting) seconded by Buck. The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas 9 nays none. The motion to reconsider was declared carried and the yeas and nays called on the original motion to adopt resulting yeas none. Nays Buck Bush Conyer Cowan Embaugh Davidson Goble Love Wilson yeas 0 nays nine and the resolution was declared lost.

Yeas 9 nays none and the resolution was declared adopted.

A resolution declaring it necessary to improve certain streets and alleys therein named was read (being for the construction of lateral sewer no 17 as shown on the plans) and Bush moved the same be adopted seconded by Davidson. the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Buck Bush

and the result announced Yras 6 nays 3 and
the resolution was declared lost.

A resolution declaring it

and Davidson moved the same be adopted
seconded by Conger. Bush moved that the
resolution be laid on the table. seconded by Conger
and carried.

Report of Fire
Committee

The fire Committee submitted the
following report: We the fire committee beg leave
to report that the department is in need of at
least \$1000 feet of cotton rubber lined hose, also
tower for properly drying the same, ten call
men to be selected by the fire committee
and chief. Said call men would be expected
to respond to all fire alarms and to be paid
by the hour for actual services rendered, also one
double hydrant gate. The above mentioned
items are only a few of the most important
and are of absolute necessity at this time for
the protection of life and property and the
extinguishment of fire." Signed C. H. Bush
C. C. Davidson. A. B. Love. On motion of
Gabele the report was accepted and
ordered placed on file

Bush offered the following
resolution and moved its adoption.

Resolution to
Purchase Hose

Be it resolved that the Committee on fire be and are hereby authorized to purchase 1000 feet of good cotton rubber lined fire hose. seconded by Conger. Lorr moved to amend by including the finance committee seconded by Gabele Carried. The yeas and nays were called on the motion as amended resulting yeas Buck Bush Conger Cowan Crumbrough Davidson Gabele Lorr Wilson. Yeas 9 nays none. and the resolution was declared adopted.

Resolution to
Employ minute
men for fire dept

Bush offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:
"Resolved by the Council of the City of Alliance that the committee on fire be and are hereby allowed to employ men not to exceed ten in number to be known as minute men whose duties shall be to assist the regular fire department in extinguishing fire. The pay for services rendered by such minute men shall not exceed 40 cents per hour for actual services rendered"

Davidson seconded the motion to adopt. The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Buck Bush Conger Cowan Crumbrough Davidson Gabele Lorr Wilson. Yeas 9 nays none and the resolution was declared adopted.

Prepare plans for
Hose tower

Bush offered the following resolution "Be it resolved by the Council that the committee on fire be and are hereby authorized to prepare plans and specifications and estimated cost of hose tower. The committee to answer to the above named requisitions at the next meeting of Council"

Buck moved the adoption of the resolution seconded by Davidson and carried yeas 9 nays none.

Incandescient
Light at Union
Ave Bridge

The following resolution was offered
Be it resolved that the committee on public lights be and are hereby instructed to place or have placed as the committee may direct under the Union Ave bridge

" One incandescent light said light to burn from dark to daylight every night" Bush moved the adoption of the resolution seconded by Gable. The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas 9 nays none and the resolution was declared adopted.

On motion of Bush it was agreed that when council adjourn it be to meet in one week

Ordinance to repeal Sewer Commission

An Ordinance to repeal an Ordinance creating a Board of Sewer Commissioners passed July 13th 1887. was read first time and Bush moved that the rules be suspended and the ordinance be read second time seconded by Gable. The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas 9 nays none. The rules were declared suspended the ordinance was read second time and Bush moved that the rules be again suspended and the ordinance be read third time seconded by Gable and carried yeas 9 nays none. The Ordinance was read third time and Gable moved the same be placed on its passage seconded by Davidson. The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Buck Bush Conyer Cowan Davidson Gable Crumbaugh Love Wilson yeas 9 nays none and the ordinance was declared passed.

Resolution to file restitution bond

The Solicitor presented the following resolution: "Resolved by the Council of the City of Alliance Ohio that the Solicitor is hereby directed to apply to the proper Court of this County for leave to file a restitution bond in the case of John Coftis Et al vs the City of Alliance Ohio and if the same is granted the Mayor and Clerk are authorized to sign such bond on behalf of the City" Buck moved the adoption of the resolution seconded by Davidson and carried yeas Buck Bush Conyer Cowan Crumbaugh Davidson Gable Love Wilson yeas 9 nays 0

The Solicitor offered the following
 resolution "Be it resolved by the Council of
