

Council Chamber Alliance Ohio Feb 19th 1894

Council met in regular session with President Wilson presiding and the following members present. Buck. Bush. Conger Cowan Crumbaugh Davidson Gable Lovv Sefert Williams Absent. Harris. Minutes of preceeding meetings read and approved

Communication from O Shidler relative to street sweeping

A communication from Obadiah Shidler making a proposition to purchase a street sweeper and keep the paved streets of the city clean and free from mud and dirt for the sum of 20^{cts} per cubic yard for all dirt removed, ^{was read} and on motion of Buck the same was referred to the Street committee to investigate and report at next meeting

Repair Main Street

Buck reported a depression in the pavement on Main Street in front of the Keplinger house caused by putting in water pipe and not properly replacing the pavement and moved that the water works company be notified to repair the same. seconded by Davidson and carried

Keep water off sidewalks on Arch street

Buck also reported the sidewalk on Arch Street between Grant and Roseberry streets being overflowed by water coming off Linden Avenue and the same was referred to the Street committee and engineer to report at next ^{meeting} east of relieving same

Vote on resolution to construct no 4 lateral sewer

Bush moved that the resolution declaring it necessary to construct Lateral sewer no 4. be taken from the table seconded by Williams and carried. The Yeas and nays were called on the motion to adopt the resolution resulting Yeas Bush Conger Cowan Davidson Gable Sefert Williams. Nays Buck Crumbaugh Lovv Wilson. Yms 7 nays 4. and the resolution was declared lost the necessary two thirds not voting in the affirmative

Report of the
Buildings & Grounds
Committee on
a tower

The Buildings and Grounds Committee to whom had been referred the question of a hose tower made the following report. "In the committee to whom the building of a hose tower was referred find that we can build a tower for this purpose at a cost not to exceed \$210⁰⁰ tower to be 8 feet at the base and six (6) feet at the top and to be not less than 63 feet high. We believe this to be the best way of fixing this on account of our not having money to build a more elaborate building."

Signed J. Brown, O. C. Conyer. On motion of Bush seconded by Davidson the report was accepted.

Order of Ordinance
to establish fire
committee

An Ordinance, Entitled An Ordinance to block a certain square in the City of Allimore. (being the ordinance which passed 1st and second reading at the preceding meeting) was read third time and Bush moved the same be placed on its final passage, seconded by Williams. The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Buck Bush Conyer Brown Emborough Davidson Gable Love Supt Williams Wilson. Yeas 11 nays 0 and the ordinance was declared passed.

Solicitor to notify
R. officials

On motion of Bush the solicitor was instructed to notify the officials of the C & O. R. R. to construct the crossing on Summit Street

Buildings & Grounds
Committee to
have Plans re
Hose tower

Buck moved that the Buildings and Grounds Committee be instructed to advertise for bids for the construction of a hose tower in accordance with their report seconded by Conyer and on Motion of Love seconded by Bush the motion was so amended ^{as} to instruct the committee to prepare plans and specifications for same.
