

Council Chamber Alliance O. March 5<sup>th</sup> 1894

Council met in regular session with President Wilson presiding and the following members present  
Buck Bush Curbough Davidson Harris Love  
Sefert Williams. Absent Conyer Cowan Goble

Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

Petition for grade  
on North Freedom

A petition asking that the grade on North Freedom avenue be amended was read and the same was referred to the Grade Committee and Engineer to report an amended grade ordinance at the next meeting.

Bills referred

Love of the finance committee reported that the committee had approved a number of bills and also reported two bills, one of J. W. Hammy for a street crossing in the 6<sup>th</sup> ward, and one of Hinshillwood & Maus for a policeman's cap which they asked Council to act upon. The bill of Hammy was referred to the Street and Sidewalk committees and the bill of Hinshillwood & Maus to the Police committee with instructions to report at next meeting.

Passage of claims  
Ordinance

The bills that had been approved were then read and Love moved they be allowed as read and that an ordinance be prepared providing for their payment. Seconded by Harris and carried. The ordinance being prepared was read and Love moved the same be placed on its passage seconded by Sefert. The yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Buck Bush Curbough Davidson Harris Love Sefert Williams Wilson Yeas 9 nays none. and the ordinance was declared passed.

Sweeper

The proposition of O Shidler to furnish a street sweeper and keep the paved streets clean which was referred to the Street Committee at the preceding meeting was taken up and the Committee reported in favor of accepting said proposition and recommended that a contract be entered into in accordance with said proposition. Davidson moved the report be adopted seconded by Williams. Bush moved to amend by having a contract prepared and have the same submitted to Council seconded by Davidson and carried.

Bush reported that Mr Lindesmith asked for grade for sidewalk in front of his property on Hester Avenue and on motion of Harris the same was referred to the Grader Committee.

Buck reported that certain parties on Milner Street west of Arch wished the grade for sidewalks and the same was referred to the Sidewalk Committee to investigate and if necessary to order stakes set.

(bring for Lateral sewer no 16) was read first time and Love moved the rules be suspended and the ordinance be read second time by title seconded by Williams the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Buck Bush Crumbaugh Davidson Crumbaugh Harris Love Defert Williams Wilson. Yeas 9 nays none. The rules were declared suspended the ordinance was read second time by title and Buck moved the rules be suspended and the ordinance be read third time seconded by Davidson the yeas and nays were called resulting: Yeas Buck Bush Davidson Defert Williams Yeas Crumbaugh Harris Love Wilson Yeas 5 nays 4 and the motion was declared lost

of hose tower

Love submitted a plan of a hose tower to be constructed at the south end of and joined to the city hall and moved the same be referred to the fire committee with power to act with the understanding that the cost was not to exceed \$140<sup>00</sup> seconded by Defert. after some discussion Love moved to amend the motion by striking out the words "fire committee" and substituting "the buildings and grounds committee" seconded by Buck and carried. the yeas and nays were then called on the motion as amended resulting; yeas Buck Lambough Davidson Harris Love Defert Wilson. Nays Bush. Williams yeas 7 nays 2 and the motion was declared carried.

Sewer in 6<sup>th</sup>  
 ward

Buck reported the necessity of some sewerage being done in the 6<sup>th</sup> ward and that it would require the putting in of about 120 feet of 12 inch tile and also reported that if the city would furnish the tile the property owners interested would be at the expense of doing the digging and laying of tile. and on motion of Harris seconded by Buck yeas 9 nays none the matter was referred to the sewer committee with power to act.

on Roseberry St

Buck reported the necessity of some sewerage on Roseberry street and the same was referred to the sewer committee with power to act.

clean up Ash st

Harris called attention to the condition of Ash street. the same being obstructed with old wagons and rubbish of various kinds and the same was referred to the street committee.

hair W Main St

Buck reported that the condition of the west end of Main street needed some attention and the same was referred to the street committee.
