

Alliance Ohio April 4th 1894

Council met in adjourned session with president Wilson in the chair and the following members present Buck Bush Conger Crumbaugh Davidson Harris Love Sefert Williams Wilson Absent Cowan Gable.

Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

Mayor's report

The Mayor's report for the month of March showing fines and licenses to the amount of \$126⁰⁰ collected and paid to the city clerk was read and on motion of Bush accepted.

Damage Claim

Mary A Miller

A communication from Mann & Bow attorneys in which she presented a claim for \$5000⁰⁰ in favor of Mary Ann Miller for damages claimed to have been sustained on Oct 2. 1893 at the corner of Vine and Park Streets. was referred to the Judiciary committee

Reading of bills and passage of Ordinance

A number of bills against the city having been approved by the finance Committee were read and Love moved the same be allowed as read and that an ordinance be prepared providing for their payment seconded by Davidson. Bush asked for a separate vote on a bill of J W Hamney of \$2474 for laying crossing. The yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Buck Crumbaugh Davidson Harris Love Sefert Wilson Nays Bush Conger Williams Yeas 7 nays 3. The ordinance being prepared was read and there not being sufficient funds in the general fund to pay the appropriations provided for. on motion of Love there was apportioned from the unapportioned fund to the general fund \$246⁰⁰ Love then moved the ordinance be placed on its passage seconded by Conger. The yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Buck Conger Crumbaugh Davidson Harris Love Sefert Williams Wilson Yeas nays Bush Yeas 10 nays none and the ordinance was declared passed

Davidson called attention to the necessity of a crossing at the intersection of Webb and

Build Crossing
at Reed and Webb
Streets

Reed Streets and moved that one be put in at that point at a cost not to exceed \$12⁰⁰ seconded by Gable. The Yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Buck Crumbaugh Davidson Gable Harris Lovv Sefert Williams Wilson Nays Bush Conger Yeas 9 nays 2 and the motion was declared carried

Petition to
increase License

A petition signed by the merchants of the city, asking council to pass an ordinance regulating the selling of goods at auction and asking that the license be increased to not less than \$25⁰⁰ per day and the same was referred to the judiciary Committee

Increase amount
allowed for crossing
at 2nd Street

Davidson moved that the sum allowed for constructing a crossing at 2nd Street and Hester avenue viz \$5⁰⁰ be increased to \$8⁰⁰ he claiming that the work could not be done for the amount originally allowed. seconded by Gable and carried Yeas Buck Crumbaugh Davidson Gable Harris Lovv Sefert Williams Nays Bush Conger Williams. Yeas 8 nays 3

Proposal for road
Scraper

Mr W. O. Hershey agent for the Fleming Mfg Co submitted the following proposition to furnish the City with a road scraper:

Will deliver one reversible road machine set up for operation freight paid for \$225⁰⁰ to be paid in six months after delivered without interest. said machine insured for two years against all breaks that is caused by flaw in material or workmanship

Fleming Mfg Co. W. O. Hershey agt on motion of Davidson the same was referred to the ^{street} judiciary committee to report at next meeting

Send Committee
to Columbus

Lovv moved that there be a committee of two appointed to go to Columbus for the purpose of getting the legislature to so amend the laws of the state as to allow corporations to purchase material and employ labor necessary to do public work without letting the same out by contract seconded by Bush

The yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas
 Buck Bush Conger Crumbough Davidson Gabelle
 Harris Love Siefert Williams Wilson Yeas 11 nays none
 The motion was declared carried and president
 Wilson appointed as said committee messrs Love and
 Davidson

Harris of the judiciary committee to whom
 had been referred the matter of the contract with the
 Stark County warehouse reported that they had not as
 yet met the board of directors and asked for further
 time report accepted and committee continued

Repair sidewalk

Bush called attention to a
 dangerous sidewalk on south west avenue between
 Broadway and High Street and the same was referred
 to the sidewalk committee with power to act

Bill of Clippinger

Bush called attention to the fact
 of J L Clippinger having obtained a judgment
 against the city in the justice court of J.P. Jaiser for
 \$9900 for detective services, and moved that the solicitor
 be instructed to carry the case to the Common Pleas
 court seconded by Williams The yeas and nays were
 called resulting yeas Bush Conger Gabelle Siefert
 Williams Nays Buck Crumbough Davidson Harris
 Love Wilson Yeas 5 nays 6 and the motion was
 declared lost.

Petition against
North Arch Street
Grade

A petition signed by P.J. Gaunt
 Henry Faubel F.C. Hartzell Wm Bradbury a B Shilling
 and the A W Coates Co by H F Coates prest. remonstrating
 against the proposed grade on north Arch Avenue
 was on motion of Bush seconded by Conger
 referred to the Judiciary Committee to
 report at next meeting.
