

Council Chamber. Alliance O. April 23rd 1894

Council met in regular session with President Bush in the Chair and the following members present. Bush Buck Conger Harris Kay Melaney Sefert Trail Williams. Absent Crubaugh Davidson. Wilson.

On Motion of Conger the reading of the minutes of the preceding meeting was dispensed with

The following resolution was offered: Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Alliance Ohio that there be added to the list of regular standing committees two other committees to be designated ~~the~~ Bridge and permanent improvements and Platting Committee these committees to consist of three members each." Conger moved the adoption of the resolution seconded by Williams the yeas and nays were called resulting Jno. Buck Conger Harris Kay Melaney Sefert Trail Williams Bush Jno. G. nays none. and the resolution was declared adopted.

Kay moved that the president of Council appoint a Committee to prepare rules for the Government of Council seconded by Trail and carried and Crest Bush appointed as such committee Kay, Trail and Conger.

Third reading
of Ordinance
to Condemn
Property

On motion of Trail it was agreed that when Council adjourn it be to meet on Tuesday evening April 24. seconded by Conger and Carried.

An Ordinance entitled an Ordinance to Condemn property for Street purposes" was read the third time. The said ordinance providing for the condemnation and appropriation of property necessary for the approaches to the contemplated overhead bridge across the R.R. Tracks at the East end of Main Street.

Solicitor to
apply for
injunction

The following resolution was then read. Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Cincinnati Ohio that the City Solicitor be and is hereby instructed to apply for an injunction restraining certain officers from selling any of the City property to satisfy the Clippinger Claim. Siefert moved the adoption of the resolution seconded by McLaney. The yeas and nays were called resulting. Yeas Conger Kay McLaney Siefert Trail Williams Bush. Nays Buck Harris. Yeas 7 nays 2 and the resolution was declared adopted.

Second reading of
Ordinance to repeal
Prohibitory Ordinance

An Ordinance to repeal an Ordinance entitled An ordinance to prohibit ale beer and porter houses

and other places where intoxicating liquors are sold at retail was read second time.

Kay moved that the Clerk be instructed to procure from the County Auditor a duplicate of the property of the Corporation as listed for taxation seconded by Conyer and Carried Yeas 9 nays none.

A communication from L. E. Chapin Sewerage Engineer stating that the Messrs Herseys sewer contractors desired an estimate for work done on the sewer contract and recommended that they be allowed the sum of \$400⁰⁰ to apply on the estimate for the month of April. and Harris moved that the same be allowed and that an Ordinance be prepared providing for the payment of same. seconded by Sefert and carried. The Ordinance being prepared was read and Buck moved the same be placed on its passage seconded by Harris. The Yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Buck Conyer Harris Kay McManey Sefert Trail Williams Buoh Yeas 9 nays none and the Ordinance was declared passed.
